








During 2021-22 the Department will roll-out the procurement of 5 bid windows (11 813 MW) in line with the Second Determination under IRP2019

To help overcome resource variability and intermittency

Investments in sustainable energy systems will put large numbers of unemployed people to work as quickly as possible (high short-term multiplier), and create assets that meet essential productive long-term future needs (high long-term multiplier).
