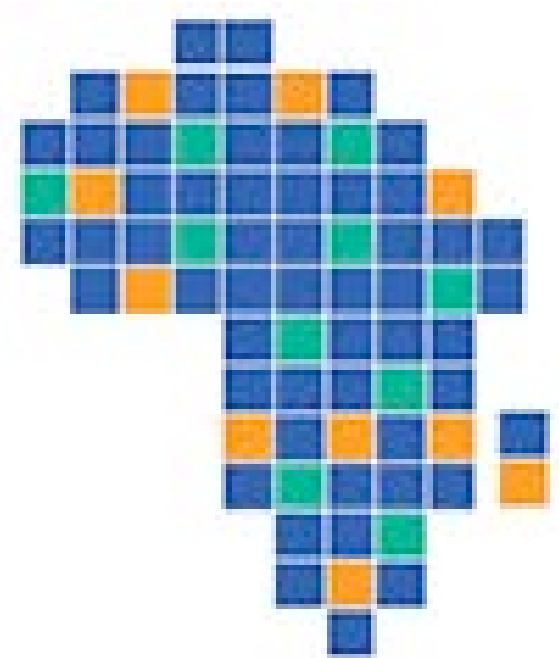

- To leverage ICT to promote sustainable development

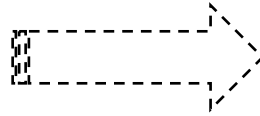
Objectives

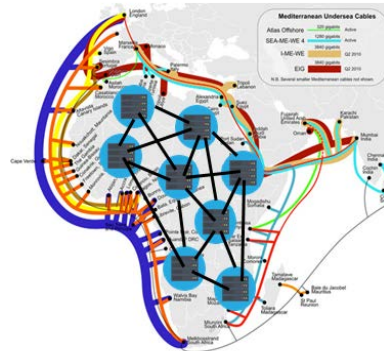

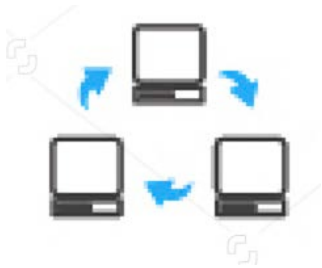
