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Highlights of the Covid-19 Situation in Africa for the Week Ending October 3, 2021²

Vaccinations: Status Update

- In the week ending October 3, 2021, over 208.6 million new Covid-19 vaccinations were administered globally, leading to an accumulated total of more than 6.3 billion since the start of the program. In terms of the geographical distribution, China accounts for 34.9% of the total number of Covid-19 vaccinations administered to date, followed by India at 14.3% and the USA at 6.2%.
- The number of African countries with data on Covid-19 vaccinations stands at 51. As of October 3, 2021, a total of 155,488,120² vaccinations had been administered in Africa, which represents 2.4% of total global vaccinations. Morocco accounts for 27.0% of the vaccinations carried out in Africa to date, followed by South Africa (11.5%) and Egypt (10.9%). According to the latest data from Africa CDC, 4.3% of Africa's population are fully vaccinated. In addition, 6.67 percent have received first dose and await the second dose. Cumulatively,10.97 percent of the population have received at least one dose.

Covid-19 Testing in Africa

- As of Sunday, October 3, 2021, over 73.2 million tests for Covid-19 had been administered in Africa, of which over 1.1 million were reported this week. Nine countries collectively account for 66.6% of the tests conducted in Africa as of October 3, 2021 namely, South Africa (24.3%), Morocco (13.3%), Egypt (5.2%), Ethiopia (4.8%), Nigeria (4.2%), Tunisia (4.0%), Rwanda (3.9%), Kenya (3.5%) and Zambia (3.4%).
- The average number of tests per 1 million people in Africa as of October 3, 2021 stands at 54,726, which is an increase of 1.5% compared to last week. Botswana continues to lead on this indicator with 746,019 tests per 1 million people, followed by Cabo Verde (628,079), Gabon (545,596), Eswatini (314,566), South Africa (299,854) and Mauritius (282,777).

Confirmed, New and Active Global Covid-19 Cases

- Globally, the total number of confirmed Covid-19 cases since the start of the pandemic reached 234,893,938, of which 90.2% have recovered. The majority of cases (32.4%) occurred in Asia, followed by Europe (25.2%), North America (22.7%), South America (16.1%) and Africa (3.6%).
- The number of new cases reported globally in the review week amounted to 3,073,898, indicating a decline of 7.4% compared to the new cases recorded in the preceding week.

- The number of global deaths due to Covid-19 reached 4,801,313, of which 53,257 were recorded in the week ending October 3, 2021; this was 6.1% lower than the number of deaths recorded in the previous week. The number of global active cases declined by 355,045 cases in the week under review making an accumulated total of 18,324,282 as of October 3, 2021.
- Africa makes 3.6% of the total global cases, 4.4% of deaths, 3.6% of recovered cases and 2.6% of active cases as of October 3, 2021, as detailed below.

Confirmed, New and Active Covid-19 Cases in Africa

- As of October 3, 2021, the total number of confirmed cases in Africa reached 8,339,903³, 69.5% of which were in seven countries, namely South Africa (34.8%), Morocco (11.2%), Tunisia (8.5%), Ethiopia (4.2%), Libya (4.1%), Egypt (3.7%) and Kenya (3.0%). The five countries with the lowest total number of reported cases were São Tomé & Príncipe, Comoros, Chad, Liberia, and Niger, with cases ranging between 3,535 in São Tomé & Príncipe and 6,042 in Niger, collectively accounting for 0.3% of the confirmed cases in Africa. Considering population size, Seychelles, Botswana, Cabo Verde, Tunisia and Namibia are the five countries with the highest number of confirmed cases per million people with rates ranging from 215,385 in Seychelles to 49,183 in Namibia.
- In the week under review, a total of 92,501 new cases were reported in Africa, which is a 15.5% increase compared to the previous week. These new cases in Africa account for 3.0% of the weekly new cases recorded globally. The Eastern Africa region accounted for 41.0% of the weekly new cases in Africa, followed by North Africa (21.7%), Southern Africa (21.6%), Central Africa (10.4%) and West Africa (5.3%).
- The total number of active cases in Africa declined by 14,075 cases to 472,621 in the week under review. Currently, eight countries collectively account for 70.0% of the active cases in Africa, namely Libya (15.8%), Algeria (12.3%), Rwanda (10.8%), South Africa (8.2%), Egypt (6.4%), Ethiopia (5.9%), the Democratic Republic of Congo (5.3%) and Uganda (5.2%).
- From a regional perspective, Southern Africa, North Africa and West Africa recorded consecutive declines in active cases in the last six weeks.

Deaths and the Case Fatality Rates in Africa

• As of October 3, 2021, a total of 212,043 deaths had been reported in Africa since the start of the pandemic, of which 52.2% were in Southern Africa, 32.1% in North Africa, 9.8% in East Africa, 4.4% in West Africa and 1.6% in Central Africa. The five countries with the highest number of reported deaths due to Covid-19 since the start of the pandemic are South Africa, Tunisia, Egypt, Morocco and Algeria, ranging from 87,780 in South Africa to 5,822 in Algeria. A total of 2,989 new deaths were reported in Africa in the week under review, which is an increase of 6.7% compared to the preceding week.

• The case fatality rate (CFR), i.e. deaths per confirmed cases for Africa, stands at 2.5%, which is higher than the global CFR rate of 2.0%. Regionally, West Africa has the lowest CFR at 1.4%, followed by Central Africa at 1.5%, East Africa at 2.1%, North Africa at 2.7% and Southern Africa at 2.8%. As of October 3, 2021, nineteen African countries recorded CFRs higher than the African average with the highest in Sudan at 7.6%, followed by Egypt (5.7%), Somalia (5.5%), Liberia (4.9%), Malawi (3.7%), Mali (3.6%), Comoros (3.5%), Zimbabwe (3.5%), Tunisia (3.5%), Chad (3.4%), Niger (3.4%), The Gambia (3.4%), South Africa (3.0%), Lesotho (3.0%), Algeria (2.9%), Namibia (2.8%), Tanzania (2.8%), Angola (2.7%) and Eswatini (2.7%).


Recovery Rates in Africa

• As of October 3, 2021, the number of recovered cases in Africa reached 7,655,239, representing 91.8% of its total confirmed cases⁴. Regionally, the recovery rates stand at 95.1% for Southern Africa and West Africa, 90.2% for North Africa, 83.7% for East Africa, and 77.7% for Central Africa. In the week under review, 103,587 newly recovered cases were reported.




Central Africa

Highlights of the Covid-19 Situation in Central Africa for the Week Ending October 3, 2021


- As of Sunday, October 3, 2021, the number of reported total cases in the Central Africa region reached 223,084. The region reported 9,605¹ new cases during the week. The total number of deaths reported since the start of the pandemic reached 3,351, recording 115 new deaths during the week. The number of total recovered cases reached 173,385, of which 0.7% were newly recovered cases during the week. The total number of active cases stands at 46,348, indicating an increase of 8,292 cases during the week. The weekly increase in the number of active cases in the region is largely attributed to Cameroon.
- Cameroon accounted for 41.4% of the total cases reported in the region since the start of the pandemic and 71.7% of the new cases reported during the week. Chad has recorded the lowest number of total cases in the Central region since the start of the pandemic at 5,044.
- The average case fatality rate (CFR) for the region stands at 1.5%. The highest CFR in the region was reported in Chad at 3.4% and the lowest in Gabon at 0.6%.

East Africa


Highlights of the Covid-19 Situation in East Africa for the Week Ending October 3, 2021

- As of Sunday, October 3, 2021, the number of total cases in the East Africa region reached 981,016. The region reported 37,931 new cases in the week, which is a more than twice¹ increase compared to the preceding week. The total number of deaths reported reached 20,710, recording 1,131 new deaths during the week. The number of total recovered cases reached 821,522², of which 4.2% were newly recovered cases during the week. The total number of active cases stands at 138,784, indicating an increase of 2,329 cases in the week. The weekly increase in the number of active cases in the region is mainly attributable to Rwanda and Burundi.
- Ethiopia accounted for 35.5% of the total cases reported in the region since the start of the pandemic, while 64.5% of the new cases reported in the region during the week is attributable to Tanzania. Comoros has reported the lowest number of total cases in the region since the start of the pandemic at 4,155.

The average case fatality rate (CFR) for the region stands at 2.1%. The highest CFR in the region was reported in Sudan at 7.6% and the lowest in Burundi at 0.2%.



North Africa

Highlights of the Covid-19 Situation in North Africa for the Week Ending October 3, 2021

- As of Sunday, October 3, 2021, the number of total cases in the North Africa region reached 2,531,904. The region reported 20,118 new cases in the week, which is a 26.1% decline compared to the preceding week. The total number of deaths reported reached 67,982 and recorded 678 new deaths during the week. The number of total recovered cases reached 2,283,152, of which 1.3% were newly recovered cases during the week. The total number of active cases stands at 180,770, indicating a decline of 9,187 cases during the week. The week. The week. The week week. The week week in the region is mainly attributable to Morocco followed by Libya and Tunisia.
- Morocco accounted for 36.9% of the total cases reported in the region since the start of the pandemic and 30.0% of the new cases in the region during the week. Mauritania has reported the lowest number of total cases in the region since the start of the pandemic which have accumulated to a total of 36,163.
- The average case fatality rate (CFR) for the region currently stands at 2.7%. The highest CFR in the region was recorded in Egypt at 5.7% and the lowest in Libya at 1.4%.

Southern Africa

Highlights of the Covid-19 Situation in Southern Africa for the Week Ending October 3, 2021

- As of Sunday, October 3, 2021, the number of total cases in the Southern Africa region reached 3,954,632. The region reported 19,968 new cases in the week, which is a 23.1% decline compared to the preceding week. The total number of deaths reported reached 110,688, recording 924 new deaths during week. The total number of recovered cases reached 3,759,817, of which 0.7% were newly recovered cases during the week. The total number of active cases stands at 84,127, indicating a decline of 9,642 cases in the week. The weekly decline in the number of active cases in the region is mainly attributable to South Africa.
- South Africa accounted for 73.5% of the total cases reported in the region since the start of the pandemic and 47.5% of the new cases in the region during the week. São Tomé & Príncipe has the lowest number of total cases reported in the region at 3,535.
- The average case fatality rate (CFR) for the region stands at 2.8%. The highest CFR in the region was reported in Malawi at 3.7% and the lowest in Mauritius at 0.5%.

Highlights of the Covid-19 Situation in West Africa for the Week Ending October 3, 2021

- As of Sunday, October 3, 2021, the number of total cases in the West Africa region reached 649,267. The region reported 4,879 new cases during the week, which is a 40.3% decline compared to the new cases reported in the preceding week. The total number of deaths reported reached 9,312, of which 141 were new deaths during the week. The number of total recovered cases reached 617,363, of which 1.7% were newly recovered cases during the week. The total number of active cases stands at 22,592, indicating a decline of 5,867 cases in the week. The weekly decline in the number of active cases in the region is mainly attributable to Benin.
- Nigeria accounted for 31.7% of the total cases reported in the West region since the start of the pandemic and 34.5% of the new cases in the region during the week. Liberia has the lowest number of total cases in the region since the start of the pandemic with a total of 5,799.
- The average case fatality rate (CFR) for the region stands at 1.4%. The highest CFR in the region was reported in Liberia at 4.9% and the lowest in Benin at 0.7%.
