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Weekly Trends in Selected Commodity Prices and Exchange Rates of African and Major Global Currencies — Week Ended November 14, 2025

Summary

Prices of crude oil, natural gas and most metals increased in the week ended 14 November 2025 compared to the previous week, while prices for most agricultural commodities declined. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices fell for crude oil and most agricultural commodities. However, natural gas, most metals, and fertilizers recorded price increases relative to the same period last year.

In terms of currency movements, three of the five major global currencies reviewed— the Euro (EUR), the Russian Ruble (RUB), and the Chinese Yuan (CNY) —appreciated against the United States Dollar (USD) compared to the previous week, while British Pound (GBP) and the Japanese Yen (JPY) depreciated. Relative to the same period of last year, all the five reviewed currencies appreciated against the USD. Majority of African currencies recorded appreciation against the US dollar compared to the previous week as well as the corresponding period of the previous year.

Energy

During the review week, international crude oil and natural gas prices increased compared to the previous week, but compared to the corresponding period of last year, crude oil prices declined while natural gas rose. Week-on-week, the prices of Brent, WTI and natural gas increased by 1.19%, 0.57% and 5.82%, respectively. In comparison to the corresponding period of last year, the prices of Brent and WTI were lower by 8.51% and 9.56%, respectively, whereas price of natural gas was higher by 17.17%. Consequently, as of November 14, 2025, prices reached USD 64.39 and USD 60.09 per barrel for Brent and WTI, respectively, and USD 4.57 per million Btu¹ for natural gas.

Metals

International prices of most reviewed metals increased on November 14, 2025, compared to their levels in the preceding week as well as the corresponding period of 2024. Compared to the previous week, prices for silver increased by 4.68%, gold by 2.07%, copper by 1.26%, and manganese ore by 0.36%. In contrast, prices fell for nickel by 1.12%, platinum by 0.04%, and cobalt by 0.03%. In comparison to their levels on November 14, 2024, prices of most metals rose, specifically cobalt by 98.16%, silver by 65.75%, platinum by 64.35%, gold by 58.73%, copper by 20.71%, and manganese ore by 6.50%, while the price of nickel fell by 4.66%.

Agricultural Commodities

On November 14, 2025, international prices of most selected agricultural commodities declined compared to their levels in the previous week as well as the corresponding period of last year. Prices fell for cocoa by 12.07%, palm oil by 2.50%, coffee arabica by 1.96%, cotton by 1.55%, and wheat HRW by 0.19%, compared to the levels in the preceding week. In contrast, prices increased for some commodities, particularly sugar by 6.10%, rubber TSR20 by 1.71%, rice by 1.15%, and corn CBT by 0.70%, during the week. Compared to their levels in the corresponding period of last year, prices fell for cocoa (39.13%), rice (30.90%), sugar (22.29%), palm oil (17.04%), wheat HRW (12.48%), cotton (11.39%), and rubber TSR20 (7.77%), while prices for coffee arabica and corn CBT increased by 43.32% and 2.68% respectively.

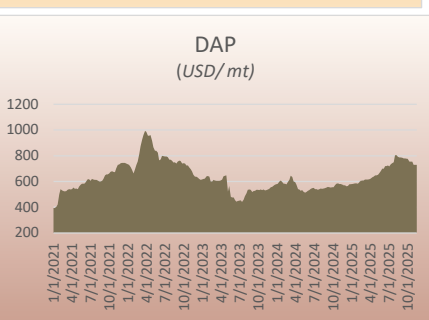
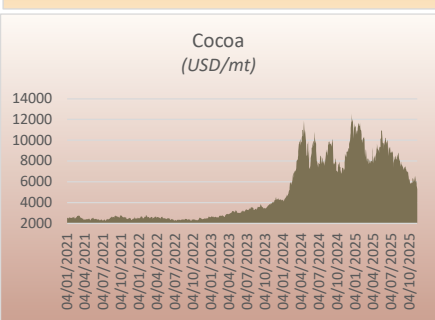
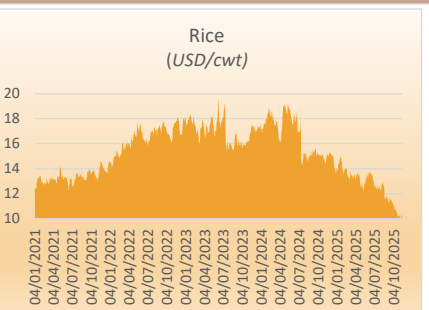
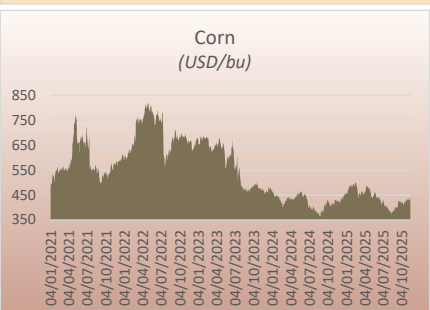
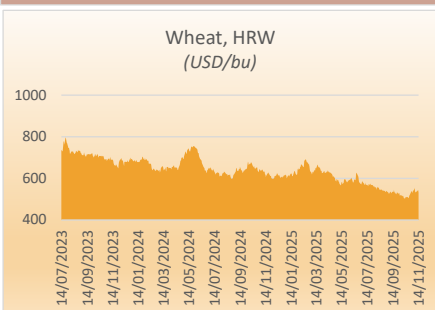
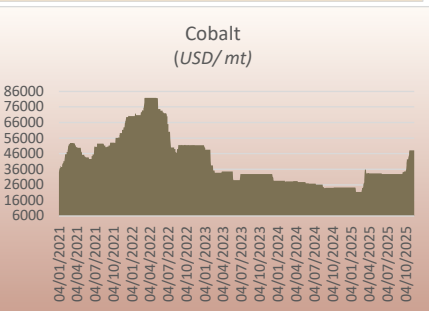
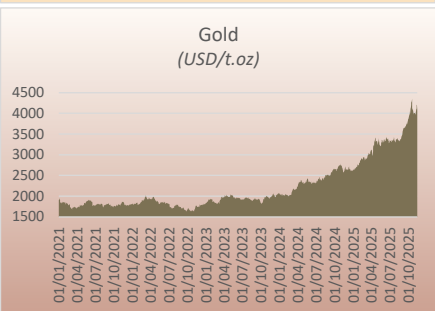
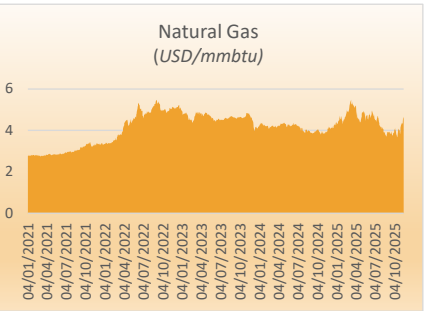
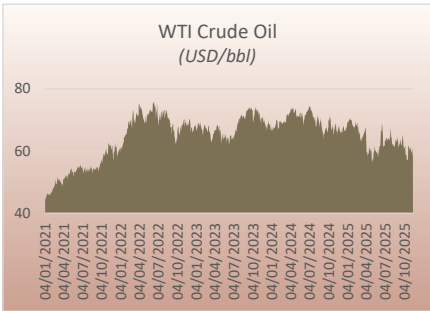
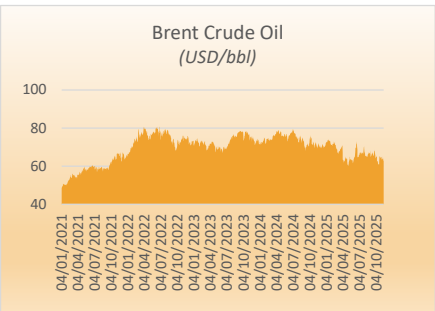
As of November 14, 2025, prices of DAP and TSP increased by 26.19% and 9.64% respectively compared to the corresponding period of last year, while price of phosphoric rock remained unchanged. When compared to the previous week, prices remained unchanged for all reviewed fertilizers.

Exchange Rates

Major Currencies: On November 14, 2025, three of the five reviewed major global currencies – the Euro (EUR), the Chinese Yuan (CNY), and the Russian Ruble (RUB)– appreciated against the USD relative to the rates on November 7, 2025, while the British Pound (GBP) and the Japanese Yen (JPY) depreciated. The week-on-week rates of appreciation against the USD were 0.36% for the CNY, 0.29% for the EUR, and 0.05% for the RUB. In contrast, the JPY and the GBP depreciated against the USD by 1.01% and 0.08% respectively. In comparison to the corresponding period of 2024, all the five reviewed currencies appreciated against the USD: the RUB by 18.28%, the EUR by 9.09%, the GBP by 3.48%, the CNY by 1.98%, and the JPY by 0.71%.

Currencies of African Countries: Most of the reviewed African currencies appreciated against the USD during the week under review, relative to the previous week. Of the 37 African currencies reviewed, 25 appreciated against the USD, while 12 depreciated. The Seychelles Rupee (SCR) recorded the highest week-on-week appreciation at 2.70%, while the Ugandan Shilling (UGX) experienced the largest depreciation at 1.77%. Compared to the corresponding period of last year, 13 African currencies depreciated against the USD, with 3 of them depreciating by more than 10.0%. However, 24 of the currencies recorded varying degrees of appreciation against the USD, ranging between 0.01% for the Mauritanian Oguiya (MRU) and 31.62% for the Ghana cedi (GHS).
