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Weekly Trends in Selected Commodity Prices and Exchange Rates of African and Major Global Currencies — Week Ended July 4, 2025

Summary

Prices of crude oil, most metals, and some agricultural commodities increased in the week ended 4 July 2025 relative to their levels in the previous week. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices were lower for crude oil, natural gas, a few metals, and some agricultural commodities. In terms of currency movements, three of the five major global currencies reviewed, namely the Euro (EUR), the Japanese Yen (JPY), and the Chinese Yuan (CNY) appreciated against the United States Dollar (USD), while the British Pound (GBP) and the Russian Ruble (RUB) depreciated, relative to their levels in the previous week. Relative to the corresponding period of last year, all the five currencies appreciated against the USD. Most of the reviewed African currencies appreciated against the USD when compared to their levels in the previous week, but depreciated relative to their levels in the corresponding period of last year.

Energy

During the week under review, international prices of crude oil increased, while that of natural gas declined compared to the preceding week. Compared to the corresponding period of last year, both crude oil and natural gas prices fell. Week-on-week, the prices of Brent and WTI increased by 2.25% and 2.26%, respectively, while price of natural gas declined by 8.83%. In comparison to the corresponding period of last year, the prices of Brent, WTI, and natural gas were lower by 15.50%, 12.15%, and 1.25%, respectively. Consequently, as of July 4, 2025, prices reached USD 68.30 and USD 67.00 per barrel for Brent and WTI, respectively, and USD 3.41 per million Btu¹ for natural gas.

Metals

International prices of most reviewed metals increased compared to their levels in the preceding week and the corresponding period of 2024. Compared to the previous week, prices increased for platinum by 4.20%, silver by 2.72%, gold by 1.92%, manganese ore by 1.34%, and nickel by 0.30%. In contrast, the price of copper fell by 0.14%. In comparison to their levels on July 4, 2024, prices of most metals increased, specifically gold by 41.53%, platinum by 39.20%, cobalt by 23.01% and silver by 21.44%. However, prices fell for manganese ore by 43.50%, nickel by 11.19%, and copper by 0.18%.

Agricultural Commodities

On July 4, 2025, international prices of most selected agricultural commodities declined compared to their levels in the previous week as well as the corresponding period of last year. Prices of most selected agricultural commodities fell compared to their levels in the preceding week, particularly coffee arabica by 5.57%, cocoa by 4.89%, rice 3.78%, sugar by 1.97%, and cotton by 1.24%. In contrast, prices of some commodities increased: corn CBT by 3.35%, rubber TSR20 by 0.68%, palm oil by 0.46%, and wheat HRW by 0.42%. Compared to their levels in the corresponding period of last year, prices fell for rice (25.52%), wheat HRW (14.99%), sugar (12.83%), cotton (7.26%) and rubber TSR20 (2.63%), while the prices for coffee arabica, cocoa, palm oil and corn CBT increased by 29.52%, 12.41%, 8.28%, and 6.94%, respectively.

Fertilizers

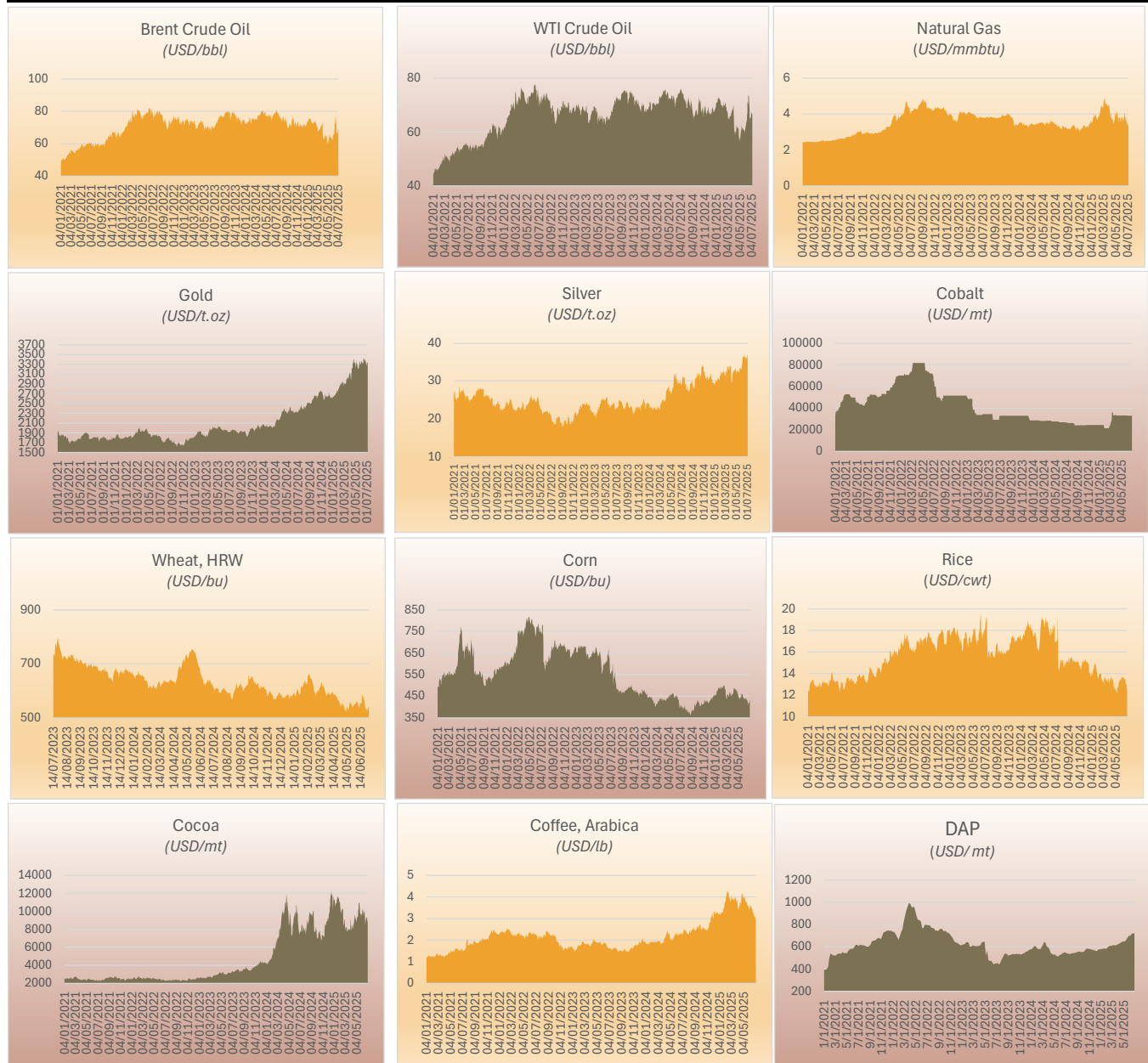
During the week under review, the price of DAP fell by 1.03% compared to the previous week, while the price of TSP remained unchanged. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices increased by 33.89% for TSP and by 32.87% for DAP. The price of phosphoric rock remained unchanged at USD 152.50 per metric ton when compared to its levels in the previous week and the corresponding period of last year.

Exchange Rates

Major Currencies: On July 4, 2025, three of the five reviewed major global currencies – the Euro (EUR), the Japanese Yen (JPY), and the Chinese Yuan (CNY) – appreciated against the USD, while the British Pound (GBP) and the Russian Ruble (RUB) depreciated, relative to the rates on June 27, 2025. The week-on-week rates of appreciation against the USD were 0.45% for the EUR, 0.10% for the JPY, and 0.10% for the CNY. In contrast, the GBP and the RUB depreciated against the USD by 0.45% and 0.14% respectively, during the week. In comparison to the corresponding period of 2024, all the reviewed currencies appreciated against the USD as follows: JPY (10.09%), EUR (9.07%), RUB (7.89%), GBP (7.29%), and CNY (1.90%).

Currencies of African Countries: Most of the reviewed African currencies appreciated against the USD during the week under review, relative to the previous week. Of the 37 African currencies reviewed, 22 currencies appreciated, while 11 depreciated against the USD. The exchange rates of the Congolese (DRC) Franc (CDF), the Gambian Dalasi (GMD), the Sierra Leonean Leone (SLL) and the Somali Shilling (SOS) to the USD remained unchanged during the week. The highest level of week-on-week currency appreciation was recorded for the South African Rand (ZAR) at 1.07%, while the largest currency depreciation was recorded for the Zambian Kwacha (ZMK) at 2.44%. Compared to the corresponding period of last year, 20 African currencies depreciated against the USD, with 5 of them depreciating by more than 10.0%. However, 17 of the currencies recorded varying degrees of appreciation against the USD, ranging between 0.09% for the Kenyan Shilling (KES) and 32.11% for the Ghanaian Cedi (GHS).
