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Weekly Trends in Selected Commodity Prices and Exchange Rates of African and Major Global Currencies — Week Ended July 11, 2025

Summary

Prices of most metals and agricultural commodities fell in the week ended 11 July 2025 relative to their levels in the previous week while the price of crude oil increased. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices declined for crude oil, natural gas, and most agricultural commodities. However, most metals and fertilizers saw price increases compared to the corresponding period of last year. In terms of currency movements, four of the five major global currencies reviewed including the Euro (EUR), the British Pound (GBP), the Japanese Yen (JPY), and the Chinese Yuan (CNY) depreciated against the United States Dollar (USD), while the Russian Ruble (RUB) appreciated, relative to their levels in the previous week. When compared to their levels in the corresponding period of last year, all the five currencies appreciated against the USD. Most of the reviewed African currencies depreciated against the USD when compared to their levels in the previous week as well as the corresponding period of last year.

Energy

During the week under review, the international price of crude oil increased, while that of natural gas declined compared to the preceding week. Compared to the corresponding period of last year, both crude oil and natural gas prices fell. Week-on-week, the prices of Brent and WTI increased by 3.02% and 2.16%, respectively, while price of natural gas declined by 2.79%. In comparison to the corresponding period of last year, the prices of Brent, WTI, and natural gas were lower by 12.95%, 10.25%, and 4.00%, respectively. Consequently, as of July 11, 2025, prices reached USD 70.36 and USD 68.45 per barrel for Brent and WTI, respectively, and USD 3.31 per million Btu¹ for natural gas.

Metals

International prices of most reviewed metals declined on July 11, 2025, compared to their levels in the preceding week, but increased compared to the corresponding period of 2024. Compared to the previous week, prices fell for copper by 2.07%, platinum by 1.12%, and nickel by 0.60%. In contrast, prices increased for silver by 4.02% and gold by 0.55%. In comparison to their levels on July 11, 2024, prices of most metals increased, specifically gold by 42.31%, platinum by 37.65%, silver by 26.20%, and cobalt by 23.01%. However, prices fell for manganese ore by 43.50%, nickel by 11.73%, and copper by 2.25%.

Agricultural Commodities

On July 11, 2025, international prices of most selected agricultural commodities declined compared to their levels in the previous week as well as the corresponding period of last year. Prices of most selected agricultural commodities fell compared to their levels in the preceding week, particularly corn CBT by 6.60%, wheat HRW by 2.19%, cotton by 1.52%, coffee arabica by 1.38%, and rice 1.31%. In contrast, prices of some commodities increased: rubber TSR20 by 1.78%, palm oil by 1.18%, sugar by 1.16% and cocoa by 0.68%. Compared to their levels in the corresponding period of last year, prices fell for rice (26.49%), wheat HRW (16.85%), sugar (11.81%), cotton (8.67%), rubber TSR20 (0.90%), and corn CBT (0.12%), while the prices for coffee arabica, cocoa and palm oil increased by 27.73%, 13.17%, and 9.56%, respectively.

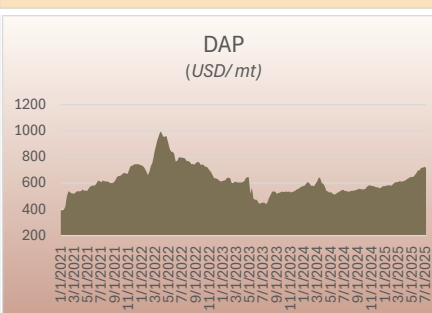
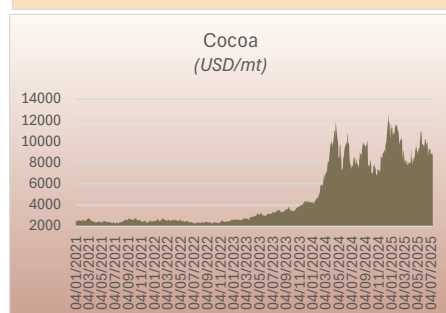
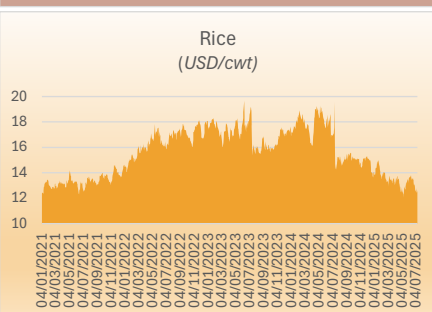
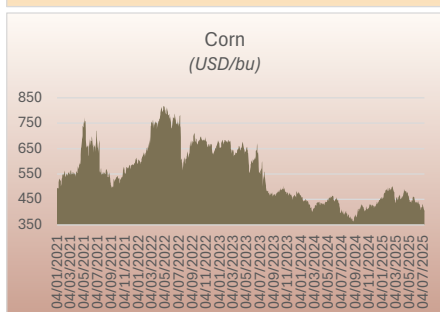
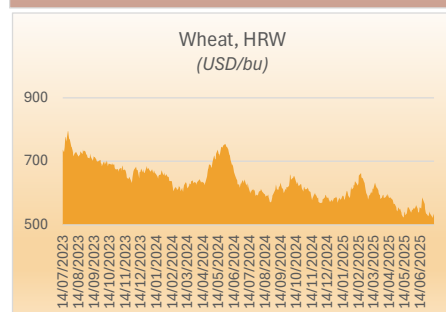
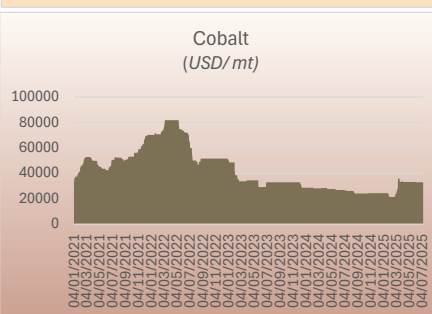
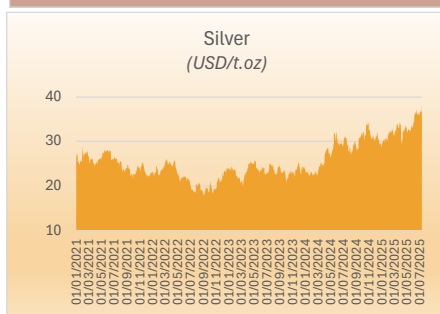
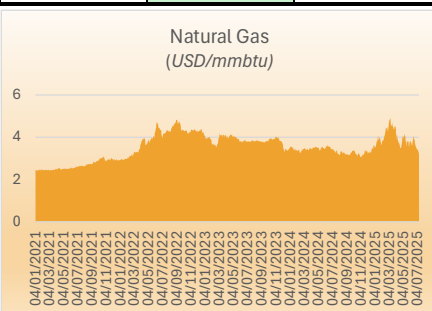
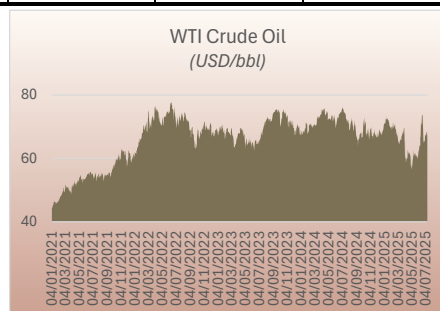
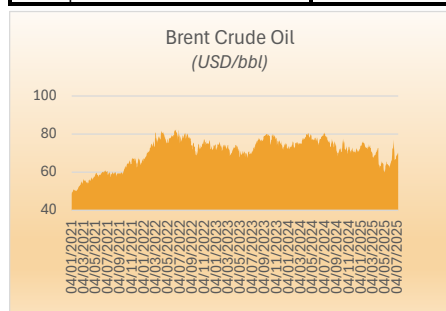
On July 11, 2025, the price of DAP increased by 2.44% compared to the previous week, while the price of TSP fell by 0.83%. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices increased by 36.11% for DAP and by 32.78% for TSP. The price of phosphoric rock remained unchanged at USD 152.50 per metric ton when compared to its levels in the previous week and the corresponding period of 2024.

Exchange Rates

Major Currencies: On July 11, 2025, four of the five reviewed major global currencies – the Euro (EUR), the British Pound (GBP), the Japanese Yen (JPY), and the Chinese Yuan (CNY)– depreciated against the USD, while the Russian Ruble (RUB) appreciated, relative to their rates in the corresponding period of 2024. The week-on-week rates of depreciation against the USD were 1.99% for the JPY, 1.04% for the GBP, 0.71% for the EUR, and 0.11% for the CNY. In contrast, the RUB appreciated against the USD by 0.99%, during the week. In comparison to the corresponding period of 2024, all the reviewed currencies appreciated against the USD as follows: RUB (11.10%), JPY (7.06%), EUR (7.05%), GBP (4.42%), and the CNY (1.30%).

Currencies of African Countries: Most of the reviewed African currencies depreciated against the USD during the week under review, relative to the previous week. Of the 37 African currencies reviewed, 25 currencies depreciated, while 12 appreciated against the USD. The highest level of week-on-week currency appreciation was recorded for Zambian Kwacha (ZMK) at 4.50%, while the largest currency depreciation was recorded for the Botswanan Pula (BWP) at 3.69%. Compared to the corresponding period of last year, 19 African currencies depreciated against the USD, with 5 of them depreciating by more than 10.0%. However, 18 of the currencies recorded varying degrees of appreciation against the USD, ranging between 0.03% for the Djiboutian Franc (DJF) and 32.47% for the Ghanaian Cedi (GHS).
