Weekly Trends in Selected Commodity Prices and Exchange Rates of African and Major Global Currencies — Week Ended September 19, 2025

Summary

Prices of crude oil, natural gas, a few metals, and most agricultural commodities declined in the week ended September 19, 2025, compared to the previous week. Similarly, when compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices fell for crude oil, natural gas, and most agricultural commodities. However, most metals and fertilizers recorded price increases relative to the same period last year.

In terms of currency movements, three of the five major global currencies reviewed—the British Pound (GBP), the Japanese Yen (JPY), and the Russian Ruble (RUB)—depreciated against the United States Dollar (USD) compared to the previous week, while the Euro (EUR) and the Chinese Yuan (CNY) appreciated. Relative to the same period last year, the RUB, EUR and GBP appreciated against the USD, whereas the JPY and CNY depreciated. Most of the reviewed African currencies appreciated against the USD both in comparison to the previous week and the corresponding period of last year.

Energy

During the week under review, the international prices of crude oil and natural gas declined compared to the preceding week as well as the corresponding period of last year. Week-on-week, the prices of Brent, WTI and natural gas fell by 0.46%, 0.02% and 1.80% respectively. In comparison to the corresponding period of last year, the prices of Brent, WTI and natural gas were lower by 7.26%, 7.43% and 11.00%, respectively. Consequently, as of September 19, 2025, prices reached USD 66.68 and USD 62.68 per barrel for Brent and WTI respectively and USD 2.89 per million Btu¹ for natural gas.

Metals

International prices of most reviewed metals increased on September 19, 2025, compared to their levels in the preceding week and the corresponding period of 2024. Compared to the previous week, prices increased for cobalt by 3.71%, silver by 2.13%, gold by 1.16%, platinum by 0.82%, and manganese ore by 0.18%. In contrast, prices fell by 0.78% apiece for copper and nickel. Similarly, in comparison to their levels on September 19, 2024, prices of most metals rose, specifically gold by 42.19%, platinum by 41.79%, cobalt by 41.56%, silver by 38.58%, and copper by 4.98%. However, prices fell for nickel by 6.50% and manganese ore by 6.09%.

Agricultural Commodities

On September 19, 2025, international prices of most selected agricultural commodities declined compared to their levels in the previous week as well as the corresponding period of last year. Relative to the previous week, prices fell for the following commodities: coffee arabica by 10.75%, sugar by 2.30%, rubber TSR20 by 1.62%, wheat HRW by 1.46%, cocoa by 0.98%, cotton by 0.81%, and palm oil 0.45%. In contrast, price increases were recorded for corn CBT (6.27%) and rice (2.45%). Compared to their levels in the corresponding period of last year, prices fell for rice (25.90%), sugar (18.15%), wheat HRW (17.72%), rubber TSR20 (13.38%), cotton (8.72%), and cocoa (6.54%), while the prices of coffee arabica, palm oil and corn CBT increased by 40.07%, 10.69%, and 4.50%, respectively.

Fertilizers

As of September 19, 2025, the prices of DAP and TSP remained unchanged compared to the previous week. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices increased by 41.18% for DAP and by 15.84% for TSP. The price of phosphoric rock remained unchanged at USD 152.50 per metric ton when compared to its levels in the previous week and the corresponding period of last year.

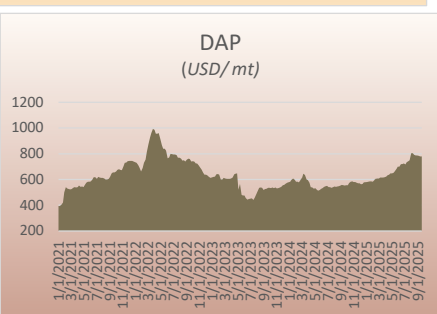
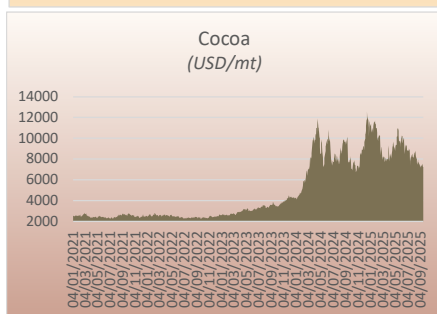
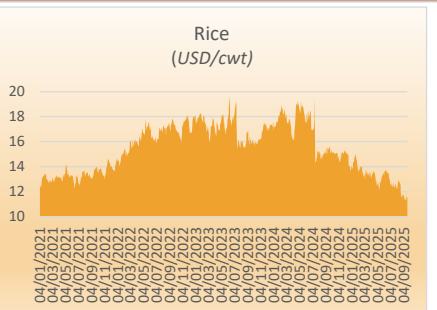
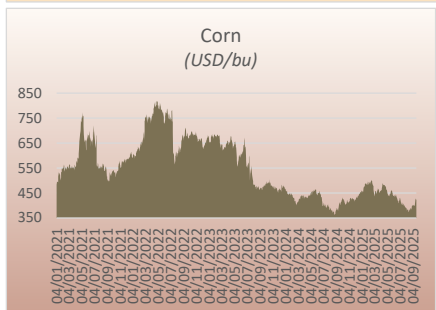
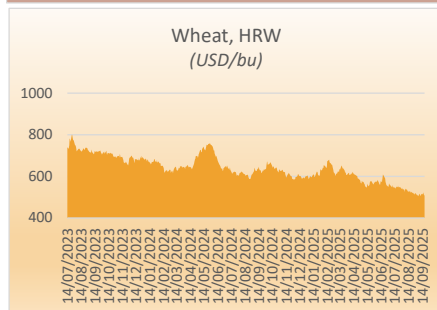
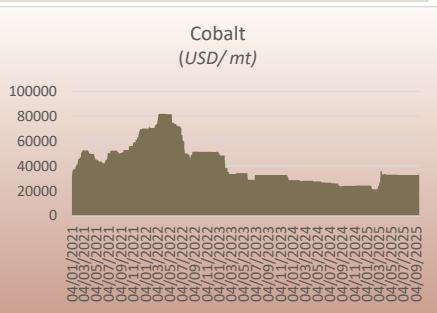
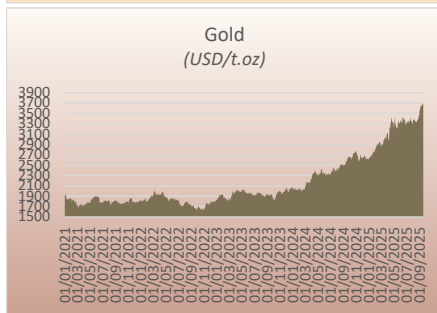
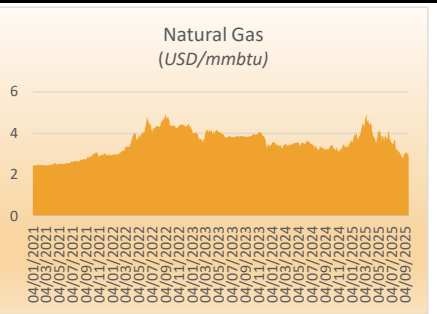
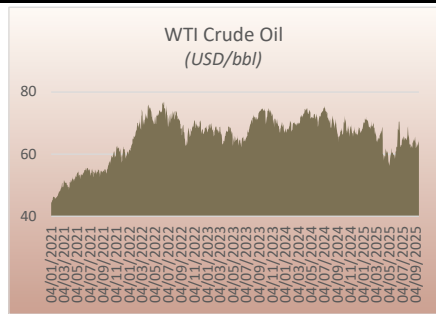
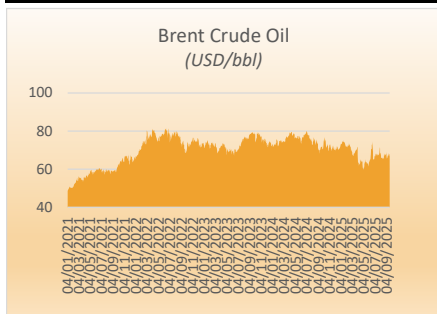
Exchange Rates

Major Currencies: On September 19, 2025, three of the five reviewed major global currencies – the British Pound (GBP), the Japanese Yen (JPY), and the Russian Ruble (RUB) - depreciated against the USD, while the Euro (EUR) and the Chinese Yuan (CNY) appreciated, relative to the rates on September 12, 2025. The week-on-week rates of depreciation against the USD were 0.57% for the GBP, 0.42% for the RUB and 0.11% for the JPY. In contrast, the EUR and the CNY appreciated against the USD by 0.22% and 0.11% respectively, during the week. In comparison to the corresponding period of 2024, three of the reviewed currencies appreciated against the USD: the RUB by 9.65%, the EUR by 5.09%, and the GBP by 1.49%. In contrast, the JPY and the CNY depreciated by 3.36% and 0.60%, respectively.

Currencies of African Countries: Most of the reviewed African currencies appreciated against the USD during the week under review, relative to the previous week. Of the 37 African currencies reviewed, 27 currencies appreciated, while 10 depreciated against the USD. The Seychelles Rupee (SCR) recorded the highest week-on-week appreciation at 1.57%, while Madagascar's Ariary (MGA) experienced the largest depreciation at 0.85%. Compared to the corresponding period of last year, 16 African currencies depreciated against the USD, with 5 of them depreciating by more than 10.0%. However, 21 of the currencies recorded varying degrees of appreciation against the USD, ranging between 0.05% for the Somalian Shilling (SOS) and 22.02% for the Ghanaian Cedi (GHS).
