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# Weekly Trends of Selected Commodity Prices and Exchange Rates of African and Major Global Currencies<sup>1</sup>:

*The situation as of Friday, October 3, 2025*

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## **Weekly Trends in Selected Commodity Prices and Exchange Rates of African and Major Global Currencies — Week Ended October 3, 2025**

### **Summary**

Prices of crude oil and most agricultural commodities fell in the week ended October 3, 2025, compared to the previous week, while prices of all reviewed metals rose. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices fell for crude oil, natural gas, and most agricultural commodities. However, most metals and fertilizers recorded price increases relative to the same period last year.

In terms of currency movements, all the five major global currencies reviewed—the Euro (EUR), the British Pound (GBP), the Japanese Yen (JPY), the Chinese Yuan (CNY) and the Russian Ruble (RUB)—appreciated against the United States Dollar (USD) compared to the previous week. Relative to the same period of last year, the RUB, the EUR, and the GBP appreciated against the USD, whereas the JPY and the CNY depreciated. Most of the African currencies reviewed appreciated against the USD compared to the previous week as well as the corresponding period of last year.

### **Energy**

**During the week under review, international crude oil prices fell while the price of natural gas increased compared to the previous week. Prices of both crude oil and natural gas remained below the levels recorded during the corresponding period of last of year.** Week-on-week, the prices of Brent and WTI declined by 6.78% and 7.36%, respectively, while price of natural gas increased by 3.68%. In comparison to the corresponding period of last year, the prices of Brent, WTI, and natural gas were lower by 13.56%, 13.23% and 9.85%, respectively. Consequently, as of October 3, 2025, prices reached USD 64.53 and USD 60.88 per barrel for Brent and WTI, respectively, and USD 3.32 per million Btu<sup>1</sup> for natural gas.

### **Metals**

**International prices of all reviewed metals increased on October 3, 2025, compared to their levels in the preceding week.** Compared to the previous week, prices increased for copper by 5.24%, silver by 4.17%, gold by 3.37%, nickel by 1.70%, platinum by 1.56%, manganese ore by 0.18% and cobalt by 0.06%. In comparison to their levels on October 3, 2024, prices of most metals rose, specifically platinum by 61.06%, silver by 49.38%, gold by 46.11%, cobalt by 43.03%, and copper by 8.61%. However, prices fell for nickel by 12.26% and manganese ore by 10.16%.

### **Agricultural Commodities**

**On October 3, 2025, international prices of most selected agricultural commodities declined compared to their levels in the previous week as well as the corresponding period of last year.** Prices of most selected agricultural commodities fell compared to their levels in the preceding week, particularly cocoa by 10.39%, wheat HRW by 1.68%, cotton by 1.66%, rubber TSR20 by 1.61%, rice by 1.20%, and corn CBT by 0.71%. In contrast, prices of few commodities increased: coffee arabica by 3.36%, palm oil 2.17%, and sugar by 0.55%. Compared to their levels in the corresponding period of last year, prices fell for rice (26.76%), wheat HRW (25.49%), sugar (18.02%), rubber TSR20 (14.64%), cocoa (11.95%), cotton (11.00%) and corn CBT (2.16%), while the prices for coffee arabica and palm oil increased by 55.03% and 3.42%, respectively.






## Fertilizers

**As of October 3, 2025, the price of DAP declined by 0.32% while that of TSP remained unchanged compared to the previous week.** When compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices increased by 39.64% for DAP and by 16.42% for TSP. The price of phosphoric rock remained unchanged at USD 152.50 per metric ton when compared to its levels in the previous week and the corresponding period of last year.

## Exchange Rates

**Major Currencies:** On October 3, 2025, all the five reviewed major global currencies – the Euro (EUR), the British Pound (GBP), the Japanese Yen (JPY), the Chinese Yuan (CNY), and the Russian Ruble (RUB) - appreciated against the USD relative to the rates on September 26, 2025. The week-on-week rates of appreciation against the USD were 1.37% for the JPY, 1.35% for the RUB, 0.59% for the GBP, 0.40% for the EUR, and 0.07% for the CNY. In comparison to the corresponding period of 2024, three of the reviewed currencies appreciated against the USD: the RUB by 13.35%, the EUR by 6.04%, and the GBP by 2.61%. In contrast, the CNY and the JPY depreciated by 1.26% and 0.53%, respectively.

**Currencies of African Countries:** Most of the reviewed African currencies appreciated against the USD during the week under review, relative to the previous week. Of the 37 African currencies reviewed, 21 currencies appreciated against the USD, while 16 depreciated. The Congolese (DRC) Franc (CDF) recorded the highest week-on-week appreciation at 7.89%, while the Ghanaian Cedi (GHS) experienced the largest depreciation at 1.22%. Compared to the corresponding period of last year, 16 African currencies depreciated against the USD, with 3 of them depreciating by more than 10.0%. However, 20 of the currencies recorded varying degrees of appreciation against the USD, ranging between 0.22% for Mozambique's Metical (MZN) and 20.76% for the Ghanaian Cedi (GHS).
