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Weekly Trends in Selected Commodity Prices and Exchange Rates of African and Major Global Currencies — Week Ended October 10, 2025

Summary

Prices of crude oil, natural gas, most agricultural commodities, metals and fertilizers declined in the week ended October 10, 2025, compared to the previous week. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices fell for crude oil, natural gas, and most agricultural commodities. However, most metals and fertilizers recorded price increases relative to the same period last year.

In terms of currency movements, four of the five major global currencies reviewed— the Euro (EUR), the British Pound (GBP), the Japanese Yen (JPY) and the Chinese Yuan (CNY)—depreciated against the United States Dollar (USD) compared to the previous week, while the Russian Ruble (RUB) appreciated. Relative to the same period of last year, the RUB, the EUR and the GBP appreciated against the USD, whereas the JPY and the CNY depreciated. Most African currencies depreciated against the US dollar compared to the previous week. However, when compared to the same period last year, the majority appreciated.

Energy

During the week under review, international prices for crude oil and natural gas fell compared to the previous week as well as the corresponding period last of year. Week-on-week, the prices of Brent, WTI and natural gas declined by 2.79%, 3.25% and 6.56%, respectively. Similarly, in comparison to the corresponding period of last year, the prices of Brent, WTI and natural gas were lower by 16.79%, 17.02% and 14.18%, respectively. Consequently, as of October 10, 2025, prices reached USD 62.73 and USD 58.90 per barrel for Brent and WTI, respectively, and USD 3.11 per million Btu¹ for natural gas.

Metals

International prices of most reviewed metals increased on October 10, 2025, compared to their levels in the preceding week, but prices were higher for most commodities compared to the corresponding period of 2024. Compared to the previous week, prices fell for copper by 1.84%, nickel by 0.99%, platinum by 0.51% and manganese ore by 0.18%. In contrast, prices increased for cobalt by 22.35%, silver by 4.47% and gold by 3.38%. In comparison to their levels on October 10, 2024, prices of most metals rose, specifically cobalt by 74.68%, platinum by 65.11%, silver by 61.98%, gold by 53.39%, and copper by 8.18%. However, prices fell for nickel by 12.89% and manganese ore by 4.63%.

Agricultural Commodities

On October 10, 2025, international prices of most selected agricultural commodities declined compared to their levels in the previous week as well as the corresponding period of last year. Prices of most selected agricultural commodities fell compared to their levels in the preceding week, particularly cocoa by 5.53%, coffee arabica by 4.53%, rice by 3.87%, wheat HRW by 2.82%, sugar by 2.25%, cotton by 2.24% and corn CBT by 1.43%. In contrast, prices of few commodities increased: palm oil by 1.17% and rubber TSR20 by 0.88%. Compared to their levels in the corresponding period of last year, prices fell for rice (29.11%), wheat HRW (27.69%), cocoa (22.33%), sugar (17.35%), cotton (13.10%), rubber TSR20 (11.00%), and corn CBT (1.31%), while the prices for coffee arabica and palm oil increased by 46.44% and 4.38%, respectively.

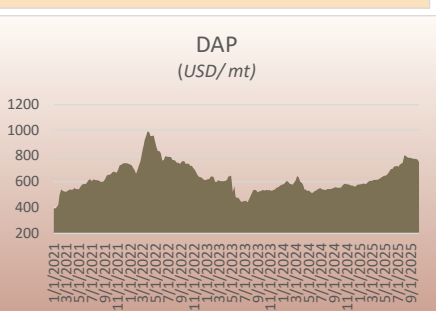
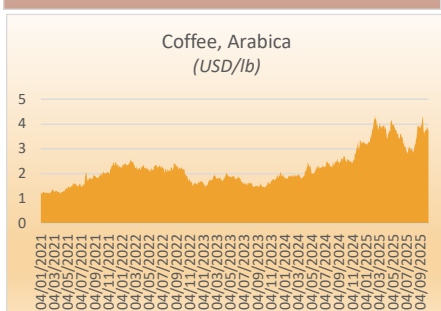
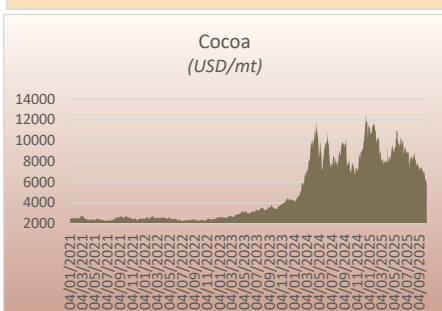
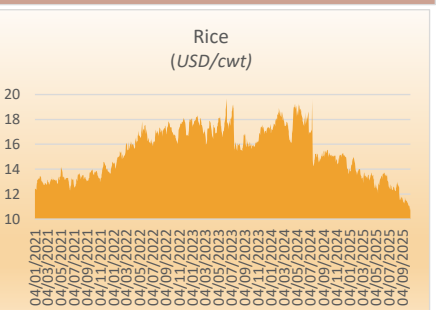
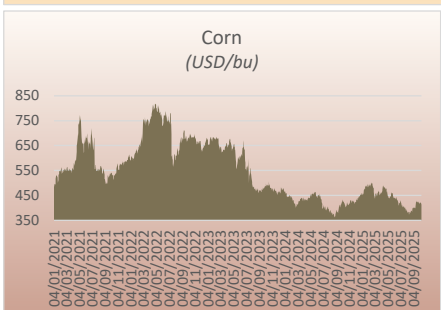
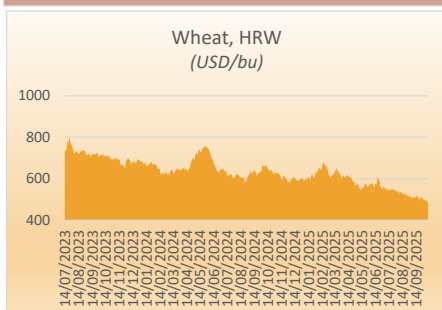
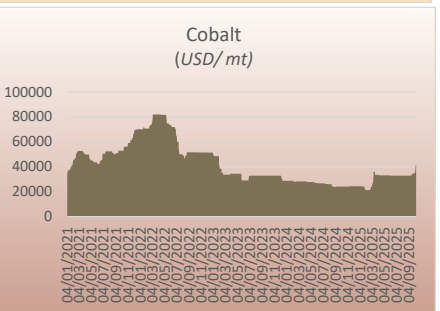
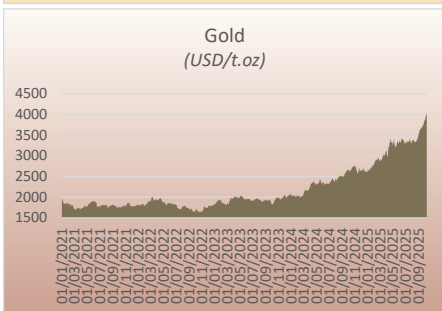
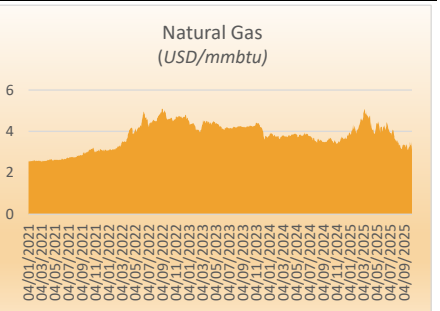
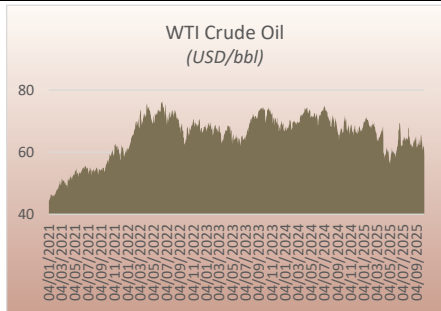
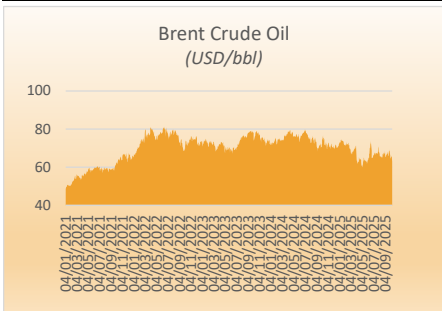
As of October 10, 2025, prices of DAP and TSP declined by 2.58% and 1.71% respectively compared to the previous week. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices increased by 32.17% for DAP and by 15.58% for TSP. The price of phosphoric rock remained unchanged at USD 152.50 per metric ton when compared to its levels in the previous week and the corresponding period of last year.

Exchange Rates

Major Currencies: On October 10, 2025, four of the five reviewed major global currencies – the Euro (EUR), the British Pound (GBP), the Japanese Yen (JPY) and the Chinese Yuan (CNY) - depreciated against the USD relative to the rates on October 3, 2025, while the Russian Ruble (RUB) appreciated. The week-on-week rates of depreciation against the USD were 2.98% for the JPY, 1.16% for the EUR, 1.00% for the GBP and 0.10% for the CNY. The RUB appreciated against the USD by 0.66% during the week. In comparison to the corresponding period of 2024, three of the reviewed currencies appreciated against the USD: the RUB by 15.59%, the EUR by 6.02% and the GBP by 2.32%. In contrast, the JPY and the CNY depreciated by 1.99% and 0.70%, respectively.

Currencies of African Countries: Most of the reviewed African currencies depreciated against the USD during the week under review, relative to the previous week. Of the 37 African currencies reviewed, 25 currencies depreciated against the USD, while 12 appreciated. The Congolese (DRC) Franc (CDF) recorded the highest week-on-week appreciation at 5.42%, while the Ethiopian Birr (ETB) experienced the largest depreciation at 1.59%. Compared to the corresponding period of last year, 17 African currencies depreciated against the USD, with 3 of them depreciating by more than 10.0%. However, 20 of the currencies recorded varying degrees of appreciation against the USD, ranging between 0.01% for the Djiboutian Franc (DJF) and 23.74% for the Ghanaian Cedi (GHS).
