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Weekly Trends in Selected Commodity Prices and Exchange Rates of African and Major Global Currencies — Week Ended October 24, 2025

Summary

Prices of crude oil, natural gas, and most agricultural commodities increased in the week ended October 24, 2025, compared to the previous week. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices fell for crude oil, natural gas, and most agricultural commodities. However, most metals and fertilizers recorded price increases relative to the same period last year.

In terms of currency movements, three of the five major global currencies reviewed— the Euro (EUR), the British Pound (GBP), and the Japanese Yen (JPY)— depreciated against the United States Dollar (USD) compared to the previous week while the Chinese Yuan (CNY) and the Russian Ruble (RUB) appreciated. Relative to the same period of last year, the RUB, the EUR, and the GBP appreciated against the USD, whereas the CNY and the JPY depreciated. Majority of African currencies recorded a depreciation against the US dollar compared to the previous week, but appreciated relative to the corresponding period of the previous year

Energy

During the week under review, international crude oil and natural gas prices increased compared to the previous week, but fell compared to the corresponding period of last year. Week-on-week, the prices of Brent, WTI, and natural gas increased by 7.59%, 7.61%, and 9.84%, respectively. However, in comparison to the corresponding period of last year, the prices of Brent, WTI, and natural gas were lower by 8.40%, 9.10% and 7.11%, respectively. Consequently, as of October 24, 2025, prices reached USD 65.94 and USD 61.50 per barrel for Brent and WTI, respectively, and USD 3.30 per million Btu¹ for natural gas.

Metals

International prices of most reviewed metals fell on October 24, 2025, compared to their levels in the preceding week, where prices were higher compared to the corresponding period of 2024. Compared to the previous week, prices fell for silver by 6.34%, gold by 3.26%, manganese ore by 1.26%, and platinum by 0.61%. In contrast, prices increased for cobalt by 10.03%, copper by 3.38% and nickel by 1.55%. In comparison to their levels on October 24, 2024, prices of most metals rose, specifically cobalt by 98.59%, platinum by 57.16%, gold by 50.46%, silver by 44.77%, copper by 15.31%, and manganese ore by 8.70%, while the price of nickel fell by 5.73%.

Agricultural Commodities

On October 24, 2025, international prices of most selected agricultural commodities increased compared to their levels in the previous week, but were lower compared to the corresponding period of last year. Prices of increased for cocoa by 7.19%, rubber TSR20 by 2.41%, wheat HRW by 2.03%, coffee arabica by 1.40%, and corn CBT by 0.18% compared to the levels in the preceding week. In contrast, prices of some commodities declined: rice by 4.33%, sugar by 3.42%, palm oil by 1.21% and cotton by 0.12%. Compared to their levels in the corresponding period of last year, prices fell for rice (32.45%), sugar (23.11%), wheat HRW (21.85%), cotton (12.21%), rubber TSR20 (11.17%), cocoa (6.47%), and palm oil (3.76%), while the prices for coffee arabica and corn CBT increased by 64.19% and 0.42%, respectively.

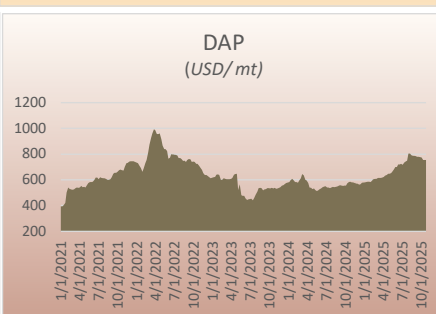
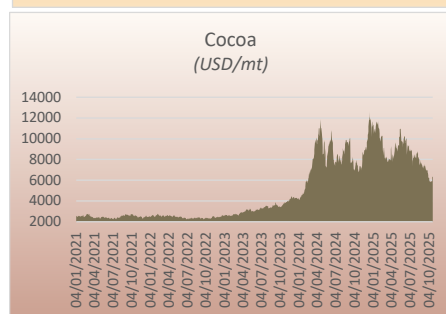
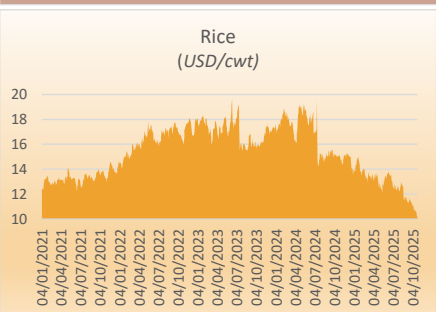
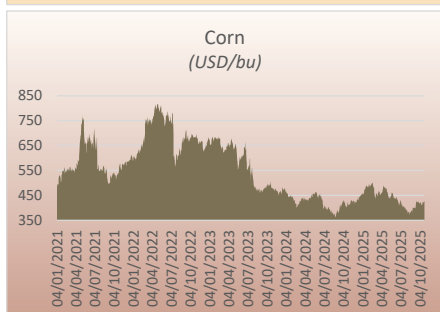
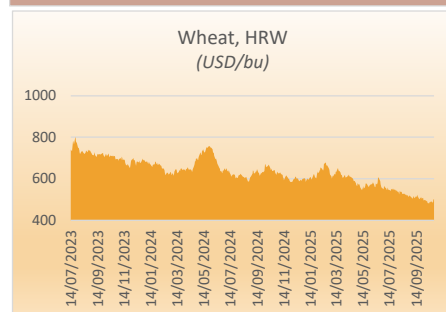
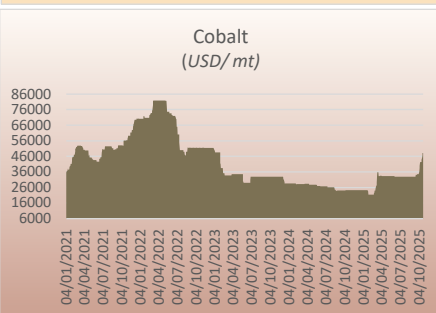
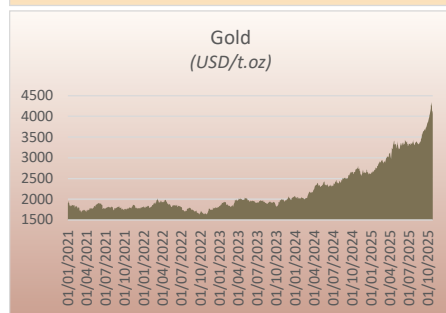
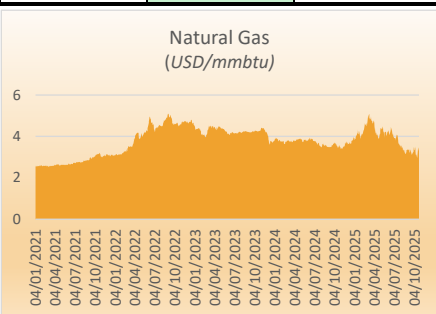
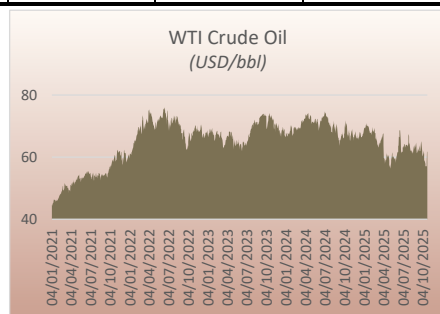
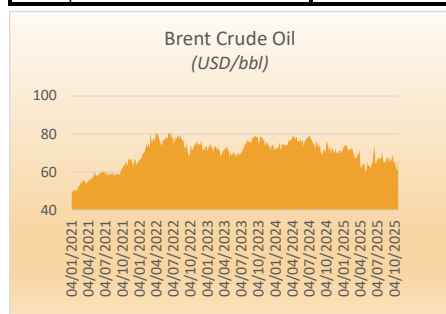
As of October 24, 2025, prices of DAP and TSP increased by 29.06% and 9.55% respectively compared to the corresponding period of last year, while price of phosphoric rock remained unchanged. When compared to the previous week, prices remained unchanged for DAP and phosphoric rock while the price of TSP fell by 5.22%.

Exchange Rates

Major Currencies: On October 24, 2025, three of the five reviewed major global currencies – the Euro (EUR), the British Pound (GBP), and the Japanese Yen (JPY) - depreciated against the USD relative to the rates on October 17, 2025, while the Chinese Yuan (CNY) and the Russian Ruble (RUB) appreciated. The week-on-week rates of depreciation against the USD were 1.62% for the JPY, 0.91% for the GBP, and 0.39% for the EUR. In contrast, the RUB and the CNY appreciated against the USD by 1.92% and 0.02%, respectively. In comparison to the corresponding period of 2024, three of the reviewed currencies appreciated against the USD: the RUB by 17.16%, the EUR by 7.02%, and the GBP by 2.53%. In contrast, the JPY and the CNY slightly depreciated.

Currencies of African Countries: Most of the reviewed African currencies depreciated against the USD during the week under review, relative to the previous week. Of the 37 African currencies reviewed, 23 currencies depreciated against the USD, while 12 appreciated. The exchange rates of the Djibouti's Franc (DJF) and the Sierra Leonean Leone (SLL) to the USD remained unchanged during the week. The Congolese (DRC) Franc (CDF) recorded the highest week-on-week appreciation at 19.25%, while the Ghanaian Cedi (GHS) experienced the largest depreciation at 1.45%. Compared to the corresponding period of last year, 16 African currencies depreciated against the USD, with 3 of them depreciating by more than 10.0%. However, 20 of the currencies recorded varying degrees of appreciation against the USD, ranging between 0.06% for the Djiboutian Franc (DJF) and 32.97% for the Ghana cedi (GHS).
