Weekly Trends in Selected Commodity Prices and Exchange Rates of African and Major Global Currencies — Week Ended October 31, 2025

Summary

Prices of crude oil, most metals and agricultural commodities including fertilizers declined in the week ended 31 October 2025 compared to the previous week. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices fell for crude oil and most agricultural commodities. However, natural gas, most metals, and fertilizers recorded price increases relative to the same period last year.

In terms of currency movements, four of the five major global currencies reviewed— the Euro (EUR), the British Pound (GBP), the Japanese Yen (JPY), and the Russian Ruble (RUB) — depreciated against the United States Dollar (USD) compared to the previous week while the Chinese Yuan (CNY) appreciated. Relative to the same period of last year, the RUB, the EUR, the GBP, and the CNY appreciated against the USD, whereas the JPY depreciated. Majority of African currencies recorded a depreciation against the US dollar compared to the previous week, but appreciated relative to the corresponding period of the previous year

Energy

During the review week, international crude oil prices declined compared to both the previous week and the corresponding period of last year, while natural gas prices rose. Week-on-week, the prices of Brent and WTI fell by 0.66% and 0.85%, respectively, while the price of natural gas increased by 3.23%. In comparison to the corresponding period of last year, the prices of Brent and WTI were lower by 8.49% and 8.56%, respectively, whereas price of natural gas was higher by 7.42%. Consequently, as of October 31, 2025, prices reached USD 64.77 and USD 60.98 per barrel for Brent and WTI, respectively, and USD 4.12 per million Btu¹ for natural gas.

Metals

International prices of most reviewed metals fell on October 31, 2025, compared to their levels in the preceding week, while prices were higher compared to the corresponding period of 2024. Compared to the previous week, prices fell for gold by 2.68%, platinum by 2.20%, nickel by 0.88%, copper by 0.68%, and cobalt by 0.02%. In contrast, prices increased for manganese ore by 0.91% and silver by 0.12%. In comparison to their levels on October 31, 2024, prices of most metals rose, specifically cobalt by 98.44%, platinum by 58.31%, silver by 49.03%, gold by 46.11%, copper by 14.53%, and manganese ore by 9.68%, while the price of nickel fell by 3.13%.

Agricultural Commodities

On October 31, 2025, international prices of most selected agricultural commodities declined compared to their levels in the previous week as well as the corresponding period of last year. Prices fell for palm oil by 3.70%, sugar by 3.61%, coffee arabica by 2.72%, cocoa by 2.66%, and rubber TSR20 by 2.12%. compared to the levels in the preceding week. In contrast, prices of some commodities increased: wheat HRW by 4.59%, cotton by 2.09%, corn CBT by 1.95%, and rice by 1.0%. Compared to their levels in the corresponding period of last year, prices fell for rice (30.15%), sugar (27.19%), wheat HRW (16.51%), cocoa (16.13%), rubber TSR20 (13.58%), cotton (9.54%), and palm oil (8.84%), while the prices for coffee arabica and corn CBT increased by 59.13% and 5.05%, respectively.

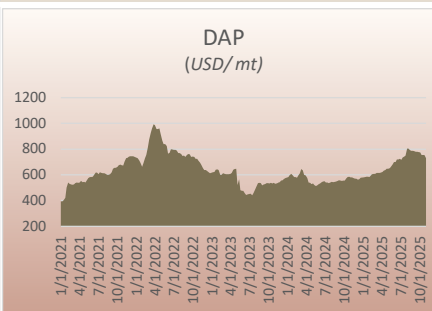
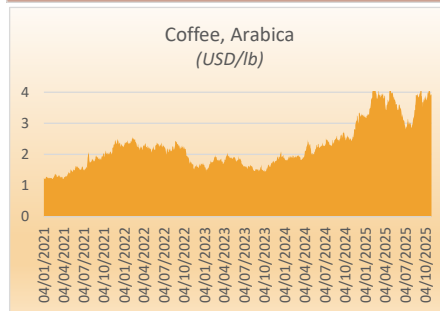
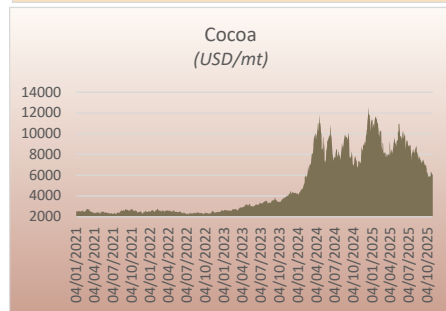
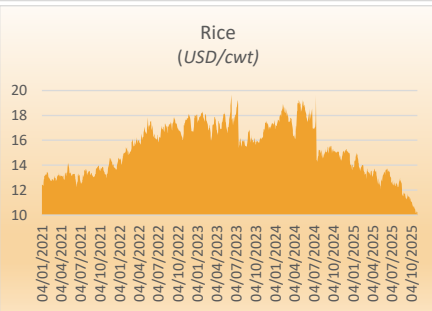
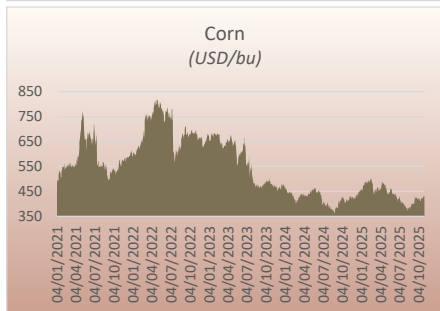
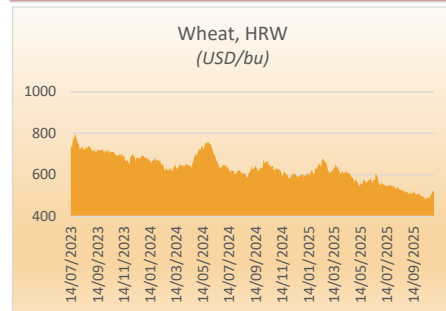
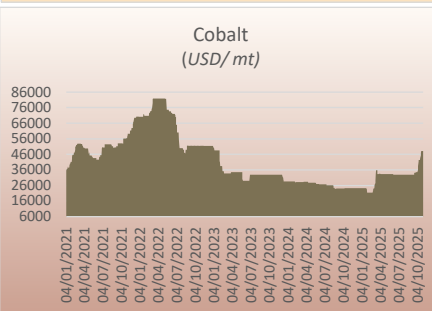
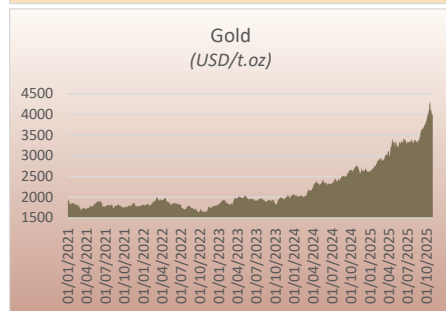
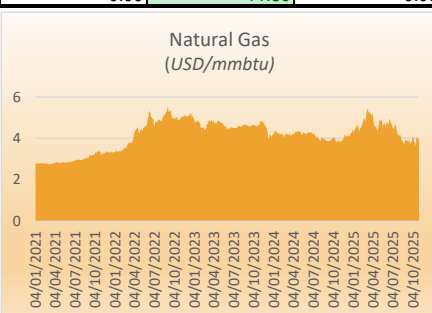
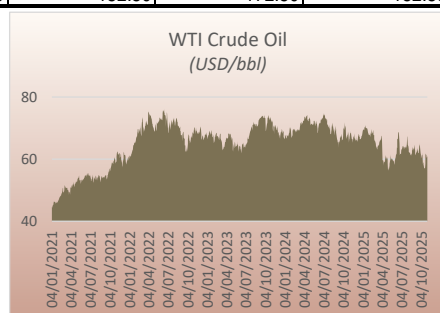
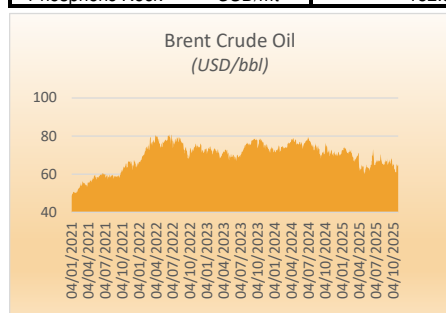
As of October 31, 2025, prices of DAP and TSP fell by 3.31% and 1.83%, respectively compared to the previous week. When compared to the corresponding period of last year prices increased by 25.86% for DAP and 8.63% for TSP. The price of phosphoric rock remained unchanged at USD 152.50 per metric ton when compared to its levels in the previous week and the corresponding period of last year.

Exchange Rates

Major Currencies: On October 31, 2025, four of the five reviewed major global currencies – the Euro (EUR), the British Pound (GBP), the Japanese Yen (JPY), and the Russian Ruble (RUB) - depreciated against the USD relative to the rates on October 17, 2025, while the Chinese Yuan (CNY) appreciated. The week-on-week rates of depreciation against the USD were 1.47% for the RUB, 1.25% for the GBP, 0.90% for the EUR, and 0.82% for the JPY. In contrast, the CNY slightly appreciated against the USD by 0.03%. In comparison to the corresponding period of 2024, four of the reviewed currencies appreciated against the USD: the RUB by 16.93%, the EUR by 5.75%, the GBP by 2.07%, and the CNY by 0.02%. In contrast, the JPY depreciated by 1.27%.

Currencies of African Countries: Most of the reviewed African currencies depreciated against the USD during the week under review, relative to the previous week. Of the 37 African currencies reviewed, 20 depreciated against the USD, while 15 appreciated. The exchange rates of the Somali Shilling (SOS) and the Kenyan Shilling (KES) to the USD remained unchanged during the week. The Seychelles Rupees (SCR) recorded the highest week-on-week appreciation at 2.91%, while the CFA Franc (XOF) and the Comoros Franc (KMF) experienced the largest depreciation at 0.88% a piece. Compared to the corresponding period of last year, 16 African currencies depreciated against the USD, with 3 of them depreciating by more than 10.0%. However, 21 of the currencies recorded varying degrees of appreciation against the USD, ranging between 0.23% for the Djiboutian Franc (DJF) and 33.16% for the Ghana cedi (GHS).
