Weekly Trends in Selected Commodity Prices and Exchange Rates of African and Major Global Currencies — Week Ended November 21, 2025

Summary

Prices of crude oil, all reviewed metals and most agricultural commodities declined in the week ended 21 November 2025 compared to the previous week. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices fell for crude oil and most agricultural commodities. However, natural gas, most metals, and fertilizers recorded price increases relative to the same period last year.

In terms of currency movements, four of the five major global currencies reviewed— the Euro (EUR), British Pound (GBP), the Japanese Yen (JPY), and the Chinese Yuan (CNY) —depreciated against the United States Dollar (USD) compared to the previous week, while the Russian Ruble (RUB) appreciated. Relative to the same period of last year, the EUR, the GBP, the CNY and the RUB appreciated against the USD, while the JPY depreciated. Majority of African currencies depreciated against the US dollar compared to the previous week but appreciated compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.

Energy

During the review week, international prices of crude oil declined compared to the previous week as well as the corresponding period of last year, while price of natural gas rose. Week-on-week, the prices of Brent and WTI fell by 2.84% and 3.15%, respectively, while price of natural gas increased by 0.31%. In comparison to the corresponding period of last year, the prices of Brent and WTI were lower by 12.41% and 13.83%, respectively, whereas price of natural gas was higher by 11.79%. Consequently, as of November 21, 2025, prices reached USD 62.56 and USD 58.06 per barrel for Brent and WTI, respectively, and USD 4.58 per million Btu¹ for natural gas.

Metals

International prices of all reviewed metals declined on November 21, 2025, compared to their levels in the preceding week, however prices rose compared to the corresponding period of 2024. Compared to the previous week, prices declined for nickel by 2.93%, platinum by 1.55%, silver by 1.12%, copper by 0.69%, gold by 0.46%, manganese ore by 0.18%, and cobalt by 0.004%. In comparison to their levels on November 21, 2024, prices of most metals rose, specifically cobalt by 98.12%, silver by 61.92%, platinum by 57.42%, gold by 52.14%, copper by 19.64%, and manganese ore by 6.51%, while the price of nickel fell by 8.01%.

Agricultural Commodities

On November 21, 2025, international prices of most selected agricultural commodities declined compared to their levels in the previous week as well as the corresponding period of last year. Prices fell for cocoa by 3.84%, sugar by 1.20%, corn CBT by 1.10%, wheat HRW by 0.89%, cotton by 0.44%, and rubber TSR20 by 0.41% compared to the levels in the preceding week. In contrast, prices increased for some commodities, particularly rice by 3.01%, palm oil by 2.45%, and coffee arabica by 0.05%, during the week. Compared to their levels in the corresponding period of last year, prices fell for cocoa (39.83%), rice (31.15%), sugar (23.54%), wheat HRW (15.56%), cotton (11.72%), palm oil (10.95%), rubber TSR20 (9.03%), and corn CBT (0.29%), while price of coffee arabica increased by 33.94%.

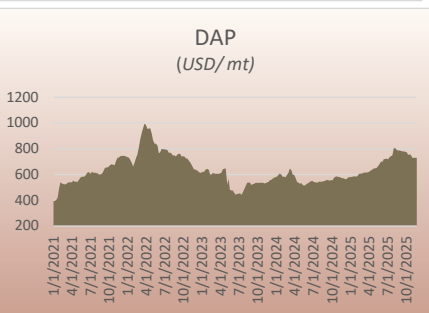
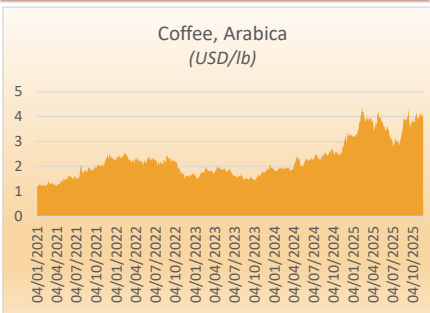
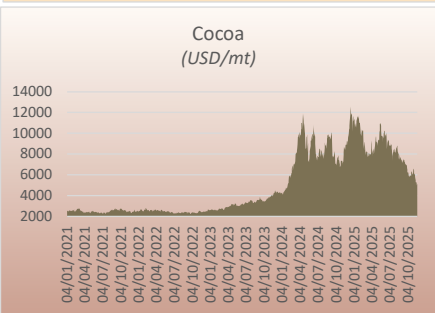
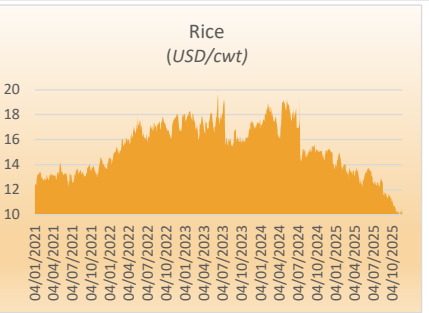
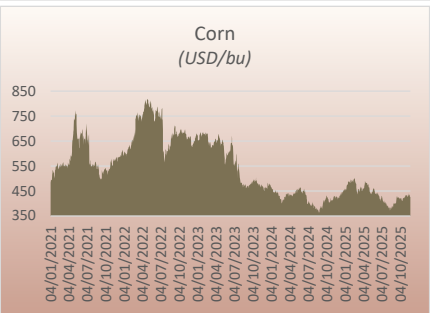
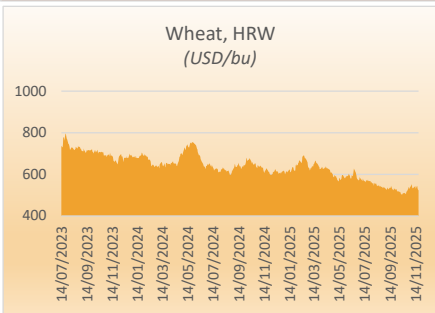
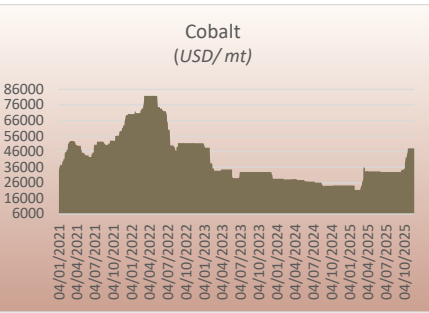
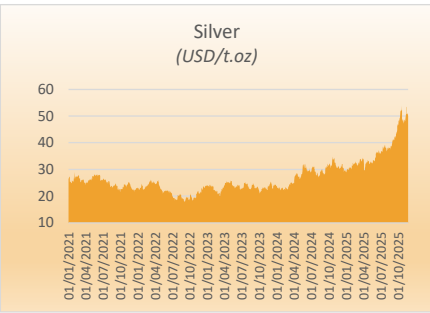
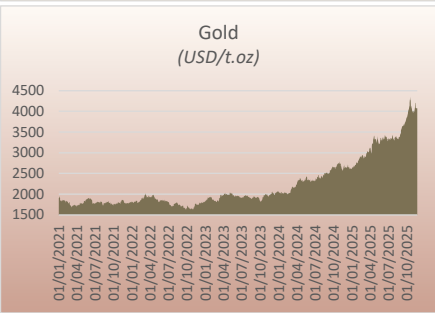
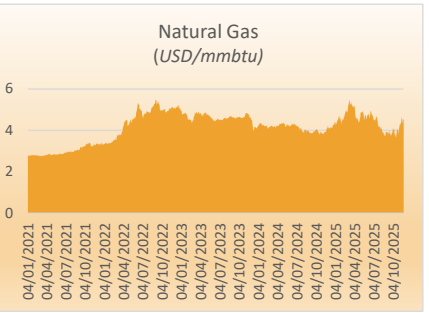
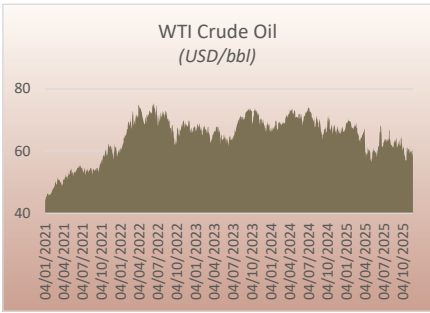
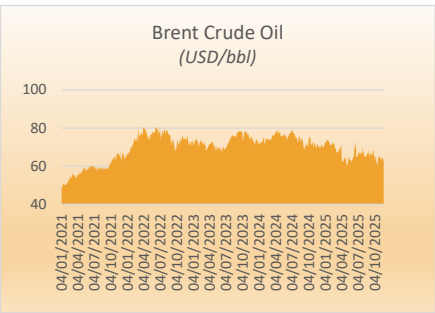
As of November 21, 2025, price increased for DAP by 0.46%, while TSP and phosphoric rock remained unchanged compared to the previous week. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices of DAP and TSP increased by 28.07% and 11.86% respectively. The price of phosphoric rock remained unchanged at USD 152.50 per metric ton when compared to its levels in the previous week and the corresponding period of last year.

Exchange Rates

Major Currencies: On November 21, 2025, four of the five reviewed major global currencies – the Euro (EUR), the British Pound (GBP), the Japanese Yen (JPY), and the Chinese Yuan (CNY) – depreciated against the USD relative to the rates on November 14, 2025, while the Russian Ruble (RUB) appreciated. The week-on-week rates of depreciation against the USD were 1.23% for the JPY, 0.93% for the EUR, 0.46% for the GBP, and 0.10% for the CNY. In contrast, the RUB appreciated against the USD by 2.81%. In comparison to the corresponding period of 2024, four of the five reviewed currencies appreciated against the USD: the RUB by 22.36%, the EUR by 8.86%, the GBP by 3.83%, and the CNY by 2.02%, while the JPY depreciated by 1.36%.

Currencies of African Countries: Most of the reviewed African currencies depreciated against the USD during the week under review, relative to the previous week. Of the 37 African currencies reviewed, 26 depreciated against the USD, while 10 appreciated. The exchange rate of the Sierra Leone Leone (SLL) to the USD remained unchanged during the week. The Ethiopian Birr (ETB) recorded the highest week-on-week appreciation at 0.33%, while the Zambian Kwacha (ZMK) experienced the largest depreciation at 2.05%. Compared to the corresponding period of last year, 15 African currencies depreciated against the USD, with 3 of them depreciating by more than 10.0%. However, 22 of the currencies recorded varying degrees of appreciation against the USD, ranging between 0.08% for the Kenyan Shilling (KES) and 30.00% for the Ghana cedi (GHS).
