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## Weekly Trends in Selected Commodity Prices and Exchange Rates of African and Major Global Currencies — Week Ending April 7, 2023

### Summary

As of April 7, 2023, international prices of most commodities including energy, some metals and agricultural products were below their levels on April 7, 2022, and the beginning of 2022 when prices started increasing. However, prices of crude oil, some metals and agricultural commodities continued to increase on a weekly basis. Among selected major currencies, namely, the Euro, British Pound and the Japanese Yen appreciated, while the Chinese Yuan and the Russian Ruble depreciated against the United States Dollar (USD) on a weekly basis. On annual basis, the Euro appreciated while the rest of the major currencies depreciated against the USD. Some African currencies appreciated against the USD on both weekly and annual basis, while most depreciated on annual basis. Annual depreciation of more than 5% against the USD was recorded for 19 African currencies.

### Energy

**As of April 7, 2023, international energy prices were lower than their levels in the same period of last year.** On a week-on-week basis, however, prices of Brent crude oil and WTI crude oil increased by 6.55% and 6.65% respectively, although price of natural gas fell by 9.25%. In comparison to their levels in the same period of last year, prices of Brent crude oil, WTI crude oil and natural gas were lower by 7.52%, 7.96% and 53.84% respectively, to reach respective prices of USD 85.12, USD 80.70 per barrel and USD 2.01 per million btu<sup>1</sup>.

### Metals

**During the week ending April 7, 2023, international prices of some metals including silver, gold and platinum increased on a week-on-week basis and were also higher than their levels on April 7, 2022.** Compared to the previous week, prices went up for silver by 3.65%, gold by 1.96% and platinum by 1.67%, while prices of nickel and copper fell by 4.35% and 2.15% respectively. In comparison to their levels on April 7, 2022, prices increased for platinum by 5.45%, gold (3.81%) and silver (1.83%), whereas prices of nickel and copper dropped by 32.34% and 14.66% respectively, during the same period.

### Agricultural Commodities

**Prices of some agricultural commodities fell on a weekly basis and were lower than prices in the same period of last year.** In the week ending April 7, 2023, international prices of some agricultural commodities fell compared to the preceding week, particularly rice by 4.48%, corn CBT by 2.57%, wheat HRW by 1.51%, and cocoa by 0.48%. In contrast, prices increased by 7.68% for coffee arabica, 6.18% for sugar and 0.51% for cotton during the week. Similarly, compared to the same period of last year, prices of some agricultural commodities fell, namely: cotton by 21.16%, coffee arabica (18.81%), wheat HRW (17.69%) and corn CBT (15.08%). In contrast, prices for sugar, cocoa and rice went up by 24.89%, 13.40% and 5.18% respectively, during the same period.

## Fertilizers

**As of April 7, 2023, global price of phosphoric rock is higher by 35.29% compared to its level in the same period of 2022, while TSP and DAP prices recorded declines of 61.40% and 35.60% respectively.** Compared to the previous week, price of TSP fell by 5.14%, whereas price of DAP increased by 1.23%. Price of phosphoric rock did not change on a weekly basis and remained at USD 345 per metric ton.

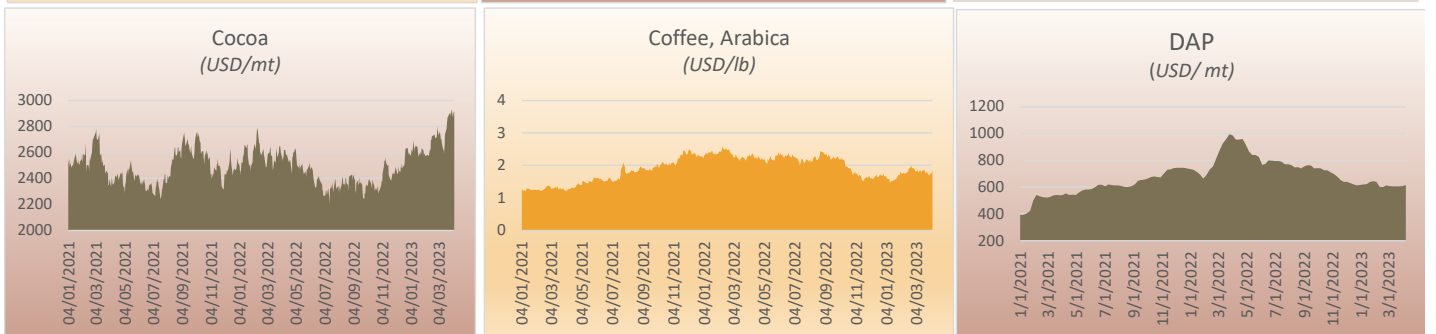
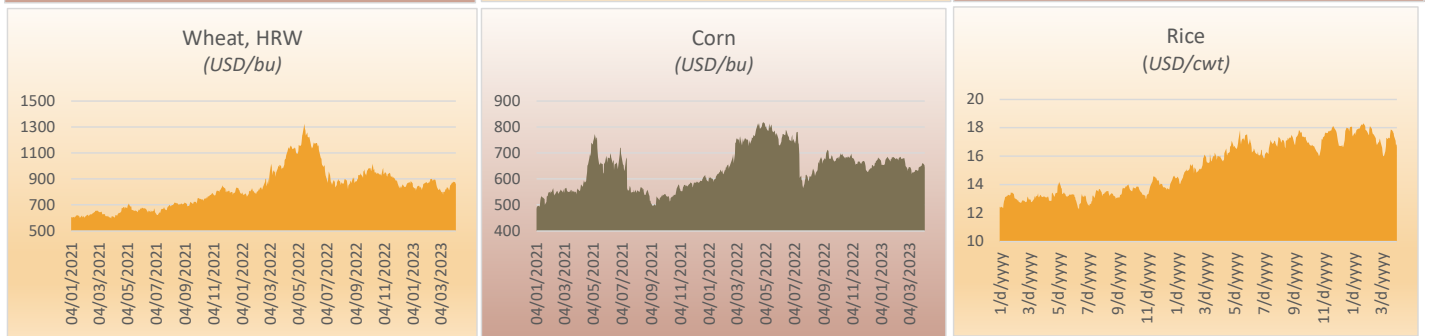
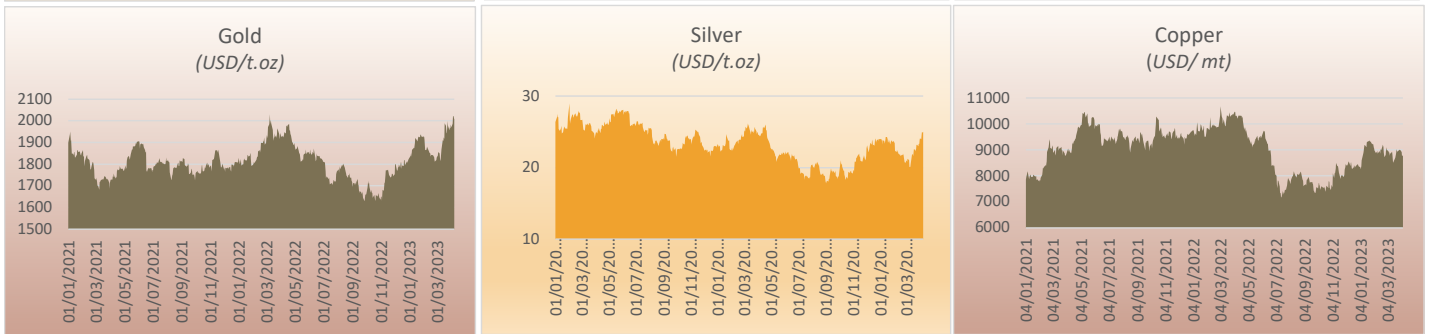
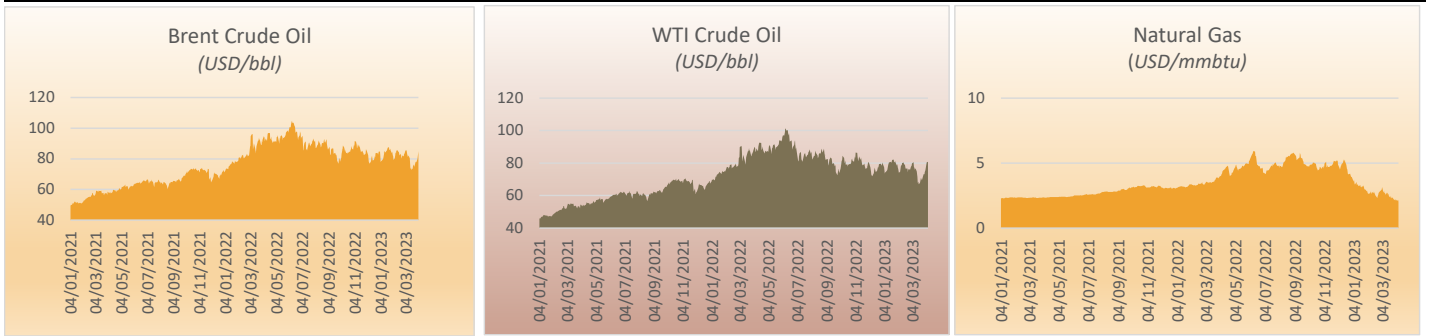
## Exchange Rates

**Major Currencies: During the week ending April 7, 2023, the Euro (EUR), the British Pound (GBP) and the Japanese Yen (JPY) appreciated against the USD, while and the Russian Ruble (RUB) and the Chinese Yuan (CNY) depreciated in comparison to the previous week.** The rates of appreciation for the GBP, JPY and EUR, against the USD, on a weekly basis, were 0.56%, 0.45% and 0.37% respectively. The RUB and the CNY depreciated against the USD by 4.85% and 0.13% respectively, during the same period. In comparison to the same period of 2022, the reviewed currencies except the EUR depreciated against the USD at varying rates, specifically by 8.06% (CNY), 6.66% (JPY), 5.13% (GBP) and 2.17% (RUB). The EUR appreciated by 0.29% against the USD during the same period.

**Currencies of African Countries: During the week ending April 7, 2023, exchange rates for African currencies fluctuated against the USD by varying degrees.** Of the 37 African currencies with updated exchange rate movements, 15 currencies recorded appreciations of varying degrees on a weekly basis, one currency was unchanged, while the rest depreciated against the USD. The highest weekly currency appreciation was recorded for the Zambian Kwacha (ZMK) at 7.33%, while the biggest depreciation was recorded for the South African Rand (ZAR) at 2.82%. On a year-on-year basis, eight African countries recorded appreciation in their currencies against the USD, while the rest recorded depreciations. These eight currencies recorded annual appreciations ranging between 6.12% for the Seychelles Rupee (SCR) and 0.30% for the CFA Franc (XOF). Compared to the same period of last year, 19 African currencies depreciated by more than 5.0% against the USD, with the two steepest declines recorded by the currencies of Zimbabwe (ZWD) at 539.02% and South Sudan (SSP) at 98.98%.
