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## Weekly Trends in Selected Commodity Prices and Exchange Rates of African and Major Global Currencies — Week Ending May 10, 2024

### Summary

In the week of May 10, 2024, prices increased for most commodities including energy, metals and most selected agricultural commodities compared to the preceding week. On an annual basis, prices increased for crude oil, some metals and agricultural commodities, whereas prices were lower for natural gas and fertilizers. The highest annual price change was recorded for cocoa, which stands three times higher than its level in the corresponding period of last year. The Japanese Yen, the Chinese Yuan, the Russian Ruble and the British Pound depreciated against the US Dollar (USD) compared to the previous week, while the Euro appreciated. On an annual basis, all the selected major currencies weakened against the USD. Most of the reviewed African currencies appreciated against the USD compared to the previous week, although most saw depreciations compared to the corresponding period of last year.

### Energy

**As of May 10, 2024, international prices for WTI crude oil and natural gas were higher compared to the preceding week while prices were lower for Brent crude oil; however, compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices were higher for crude oil, but lower for natural gas.** On a week-on-week basis, prices of WTI crude oil and natural gas increased by 0.19% and 5.14% respectively, whereas price of Brent crude oil fell by 0.20%. In comparison to the same period of last year, prices of Brent crude oil and WTI crude oil increased by 13.12% and 13.34% respectively, while price of natural gas fell by 28.44%, to reach respective levels of USD 82.79, USD 78.26 per barrel and USD 2.25 per million btu<sup>1</sup>.

### Metals

**During the week ending May 10, 2024, international prices of most selected metals increased on a week-on-week basis, prices were higher, for some commodities, compared to their levels on May 10, 2023.** Compared to the previous week, prices increased for silver by 6.11%, platinum by 4.20%, gold by 2.55% and copper by 0.95%, while price of nickel fell by 1.48%. In comparison to their levels on May 10, 2023, prices of few of the selected metals fell, specifically nickel by 15.88% and platinum by 10.36%. In contrast, prices of copper, gold and silver increased by 18.04%, 16.40% and 10.97% respectively, on an annual basis.

### Agricultural Commodities

**Prices of most agricultural commodities increased on a weekly basis, although prices were lower for some commodities compared to the same period of last year.** In the week ending May 10, 2024, international prices of selected agricultural commodities increased compared to the preceding week, particularly cocoa by 16.10%, wheat HRW by 3.54%, rice by 2.75%, corn CBT by 1.96%, rubber TSR20 by 0.56% and sugar by 0.10%. In contrast, cotton, palm oil and coffee arabica fell by 0.96%, 0.87% and 0.73% respectively. Compared to the same period of last year, prices increased for some agricultural commodities, namely: cocoa by 202.88%, rubber TSR20 (17.50%), coffee arabica (9.04%) and rice (6.12%). In contrast, prices fell for several other agricultural commodities namely corn CBT (29.40%), sugar (15.98%), wheat HRW (15.50%), palm oil (7.75%) and cotton (4.34%).

## Fertilizers

As of May 10, 2024, global prices of phosphoric rock and DAP were lower by 55.80% and 18.75% respectively, while price of TSP was higher by 3.70% compared to their levels in the same period of 2023. Compared to the previous week, price of DAP fell by 2.35%, while prices of TSP and phosphoric rock remained the same.

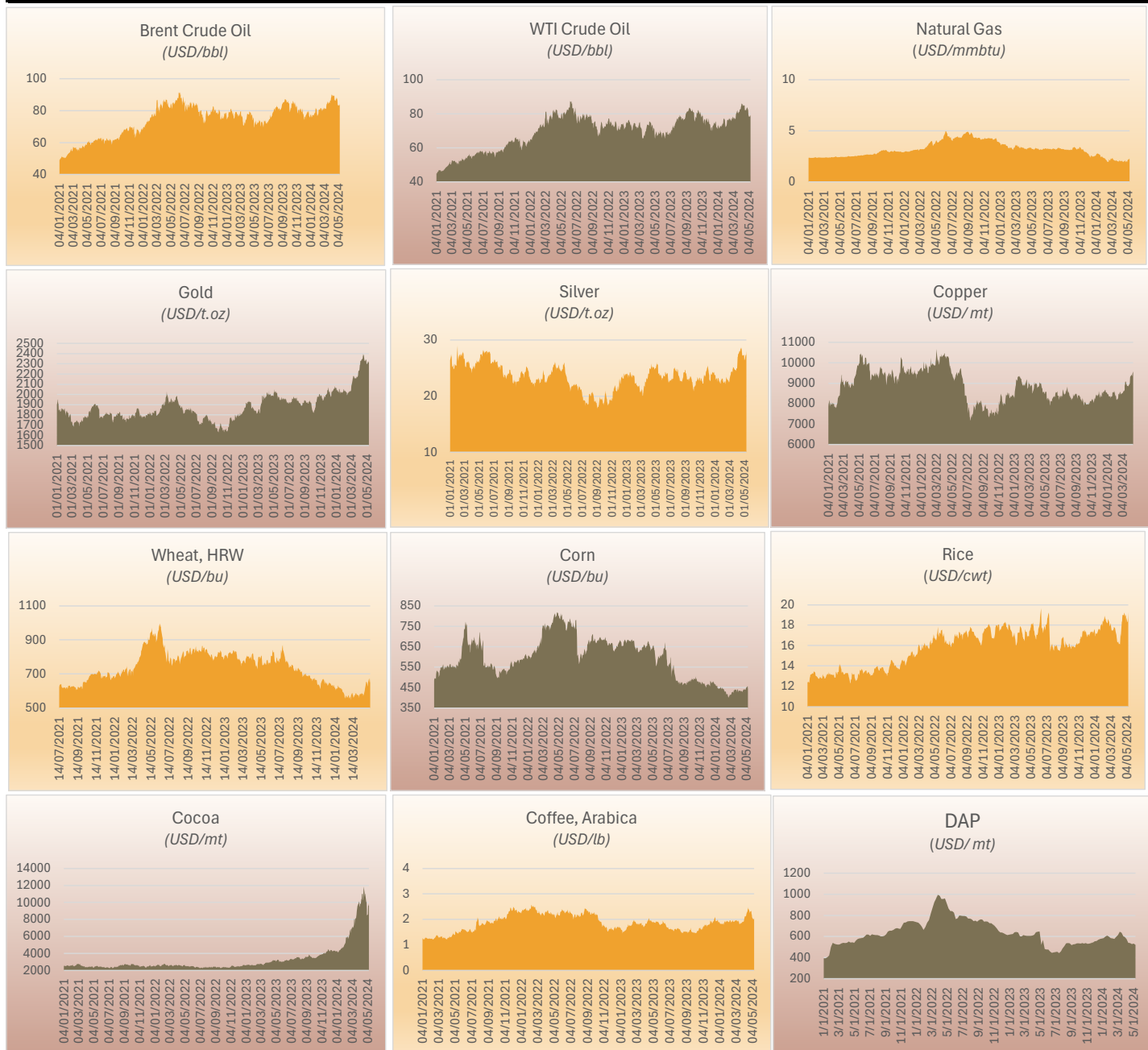
## Exchange Rates

**Major Currencies:** During the week ending May 10, 2024, four of the five selected major currencies- the Japanese yen (JPY), the Chinese Yuan (CNY), the Russian Ruble (RUB) and the British Pound- depreciated against the USD in comparison to the previous week, while the Euro (EUR) appreciated. The rates of the week-on-week depreciation against the USD were 1.93% for the JPY, 1.33% for the RUB, 0.54 for the CNY and 0.06% for the GBP. The EUR appreciated by 0.12% against the USD during the week. In comparison to the same period of 2023, all the reviewed currencies depreciated against the USD at varying rates, specifically by 21.69% (RUB), 16.00% (JPY), 4.24% (CNY), 1.81% (EUR) and 0.68% (GBP).

**Currencies of African Countries:** During the week ending May 10, 2024, exchange rates for African currencies changed against the USD by varying degrees. Of the 37 African currencies with updated exchange rate movements, 18 currencies appreciated by varying degrees on a weekly basis, exchange rate with the Gambian Dalasi (GMD) and Sudanese pound (SDG) remained unchanged, while 17 currencies depreciated against the USD. The highest weekly currency appreciation was recorded for the Kenyan Shilling (KES) which appreciated by 2.60%, while the biggest depreciation was recorded for the Nigerian Naira (NGN) at 2.95%. Compared to the same period of last year, 7 African currencies recorded appreciations against the USD, with rates ranging between 98.80% for Zimbabwe's new currency, Zimbabwe Gold (ZiG) and 0.02% for Mozambique's New Metical (MZN), while the rest depreciated. During the period, 30 African currencies depreciated against the USD, 13 of which depreciated by more than 10.0%.
