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Weekly Trends in Selected Commodity Prices and Exchange Rates of African and Major Global Currencies — Week Ending May 24, 2024

Summary

In the week of May 24, 2024, prices of most commodities including energy and metals fell compared to the preceding week, while prices increased for the majority of agricultural commodities. On an annual basis, prices increased for crude oil, most metals, agricultural commodities and fertilizers, whereas prices were lower for few commodities including natural gas, nickel, sugar, wheat, corn and phosphoric rock. The Euro, the Japanese Yen and the Chinese Yuan depreciated against the US Dollar (USD), while the British Pound and Russian Ruble appreciated, compared to the previous week. On an annual basis, the Russian Ruble, the Japanese Yen and the Chinese Yuan weakened against the USD, while the Euro and the British Pound appreciated. Most of the reviewed African currencies depreciated against the USD compared to the previous week as well as the corresponding period of last year.

Energy

As of May 24, 2024, international prices for crude oil and natural gas were lower compared to the preceding week. Compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices were higher for crude oil, but lower for natural gas. On a week-on-week basis, prices of Brent crude oil, WTI crude oil and natural gas fell by 2.21%, 2.34% and 4.04% respectively. In comparison to the same period of last year, prices of Brent crude oil and WTI crude oil increased by 10.23% and 10.81% respectively, while price of natural gas fell by 22.96%, to reach respective levels of USD 82.12, USD 77.72 per barrel and USD 2.52 per million btu¹.

Metals

During the week ending May 24, 2024, international prices of all reviewed metals fell on a week-on-week basis, however prices were higher for most commodities, compared to their levels on May 24, 2023. Compared to the previous week, prices dropped for platinum by 5.28%, nickel by 3.94%, silver by 3.91%, gold by 3.37% and copper by 3.22%. In comparison to their levels on May 24, 2023, prices increased for most of the selected metals, specifically silver by 31.02%, copper by 30.66%, gold by 19.12% and platinum by 0.13%. In contrast, price of nickel fell by 2.32%, on an annual basis.

Agricultural Commodities

Prices of most agricultural commodities increased on a weekly basis and compared to the same period of last year. In the week ending May 24, 2024, international prices of selected agricultural commodities increased compared to the preceding week, particularly cocoa by 12.87%, wheat HRW by 8.99%, cotton by 6.10%, coffee by 4.85%, rubber TSR20 by 3.38%, corn CBT by 2.71% and sugar by 1.54%. In contrast, prices of rice and palm oil fell by 2.21% and 1.12% respectively. Compared to the same period of last year, prices increased for most agricultural commodities, namely: cocoa by 175.55%, rubber TSR20 (37.17%), coffee arabica (16.09%), rice (10.38%), palm oil (7.01%) and cotton (0.35%). In contrast, prices fell for a few agricultural commodities including corn CBT (20.86%), sugar (17.67%) and wheat HRW (4.25%).






Fertilizers

As of May 24, 2024, price of phosphoric rock was lower by 55.80%, while prices of TSP and DAP were higher by 15.97% and 8.95% respectively compared to prices in the same period of 2023. Compared to the previous week, price of DAP increased by 0.98%, while prices of TSP and phosphoric rock remained the same.

Exchange Rates

Major Currencies: During the week ending May 24, 2024, three of the five selected major currencies- the Euro (EUR), the Japanese yen (JPY) and the Chinese Yuan (CNY)- depreciated against the US Dollar (USD), while the British Pound (GBP) and the Russian Ruble (RUB) appreciated. The rates of the week-on-week depreciation against the USD were 0.83% for the JPY, 0.41% for the CNY and 0.20% for the EUR. The RUB and the GBP appreciated against the USD by 1.72% and 0.25% respectively, during the week. In comparison to the same period of 2023, most of the reviewed currencies depreciated against the USD at varying rates, specifically by 14.15% (JPY), 11.42% (JPY) and 3.68% (CNY), whereas the GBP and the EUR appreciated by 1.80% and 0.05% respectively.

Currencies of African Countries: During the week ending May 24, 2024, exchange rates for African currencies changed against the USD by varying degrees. Of the 37 African currencies reviewed, 12 currencies appreciated against the USD on a week on a week basis, while 22 currencies depreciated. Exchange rate of the Congolese (DRC) Franc (CDF), the Somali Shilling (SOS) and the South Sudanese Pound (SSP), with USD, did not change during the week. The highest weekly currency appreciation was recorded for the Nigerian Naira (NGN) which appreciated by 2.59%, while the biggest depreciation was recorded for Zambian Kwacha (ZMK) at 4.33%. Compared to the same period of last year, 10 out of 36 African currencies, excluding Zimbabwe's new currency, recorded appreciations against the USD, with rates ranging between 4.32% for South Africa's Rand (ZAR) and 0.05% for CFA Franc (XOF) and Comoros Franc (KMF). During the period, 26 African currencies depreciated against the USD, 13 of which depreciated by more than 10.0%.
