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Weekly Trends in Selected Commodity Prices and Exchange Rates of African and Major Global Currencies — Week Ended June 28, 2024

Summary

In the week of June 28, 2024, prices of crude oil, some metals, and agricultural commodities increased compared to the previous week. Similarly, in contrast to the corresponding period of last year, prices were higher for some commodities including crude oil, metals, some agricultural commodities and fertilizers. However, the prices of a few commodities, specifically natural gas, nickel, wheat, corn, cotton, rice, sugar, and phosphoric rock fell when compared to their levels in the previous year. The Russian Ruble, Euro, and British Pound appreciated against the United States Dollar (USD), while the Japanese Yen and Chinese Yuan depreciated, compared to the previous week. On an annual basis, most of the reviewed currencies weakened against the USD. Most of the reviewed African currencies depreciated against the USD when compared to the levels in the previous week as well as the corresponding period of last year.

Energy

As of June 28, 2024, international prices for crude oil were higher compared to the preceding week as well as the corresponding period of last year, while price of natural gas was lower. On a week-on-week basis, prices of Brent crude oil and WTI crude oil increased by 0.79% and 1.00% respectively, whereas price of natural gas fell by 8.29%. The prices reached USD 85.00 and USD 81.54 per barrel for Brent crude oil and WTI crude oil respectively while natural gas dropped to USD 2.60 per million Btu¹ during the week under review. Similarly, in comparison to the same period of last year, prices of Brent crude oil and WTI crude oil increased by 17.53% and 19.98% respectively, while price of natural gas fell by 22.54%.

Metals

During the week ended June 28, 2024, international prices of some reviewed metals increased both on a week-on-week basis, and when compared to their levels a year ago. Compared to the previous week, prices increased for nickel by 0.39%, gold by 0.21%, and platinum by 0.14%. In contrast prices of silver and copper fell by 1.39% and 0.86%, respectively, during the week. In comparison to their levels on June 28, 2023, prices increased for most of the selected metals, specifically silver by 27.66%, gold by 21.67%, copper by 16.28%, and platinum by 8.60%, whereas price of nickel fell by 13.79%.

Agricultural Commodities

Prices of most agricultural commodities fell on a weekly basis as well as when compared to their levels last year. In the week ended June 28, 2024, international prices of some selected agricultural commodities fell compared to the preceding week, particularly cocoa by 14.07%, corn CBT by 8.68%, rice by 6.79%, rubber TSR20 by 2.42%, and wheat HRW by 0.13%. In contrast, prices increased for sugar by 5.95%, coffee arabica by 1.06%, palm oil by 1.06, and cotton by 0.66%. Compared to the same period of last year, prices increased for some agricultural commodities, namely: cocoa (134.78%), coffee arabica (38.21%), rubber TSR20 (26.92%), and palm oil (4.96%). In contrast, prices fell for most of the reviewed agricultural commodities including corn CBT (32.67%), wheat HRW (25.13%), cotton (4.87%), rice (2.97%) and sugar (2.68%).

Fertilizers

As of June 28, 2024, price of phosphoric rock was lower by 55.47%, while prices of TSP and DAP were higher by 25.00% and 21.95%, respectively, compared to prices in the corresponding period of 2023. However, when compared to the previous week, price of DAP increased by 0.46%, while prices of TSP and phosphoric rock did not change.

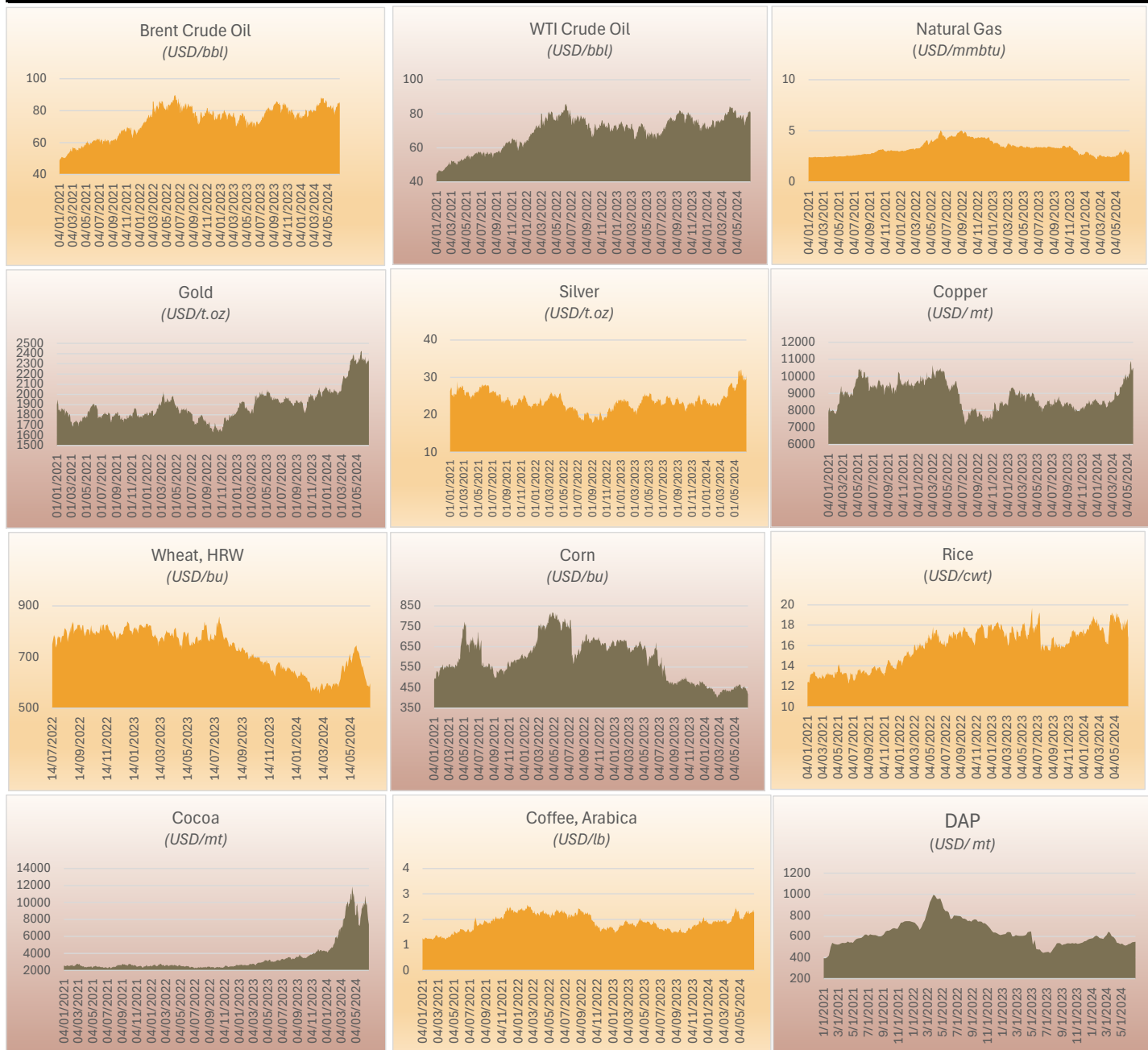
Exchange Rates

Major Currencies: During the week ended June 28, 2024, three of the five selected major global currencies - the Euro (EUR), the British Pound (GBP) and the Russian Ruble (RUB), appreciated against the USD, while the Japanese Yen (JPY) and Chinese Yuan (CNY) depreciated in comparison to the levels in previous week. The week-on-week rates of appreciation against the USD were 4.12% for the RUB, 0.21% for the EUR and 0.03% for the GBP. The JPY and CNY depreciated by 0.86% and 0.12% respectively against the USD during the week. In comparison to the same period of 2023, most of the reviewed currencies depreciated against the USD at varied rates, specifically by 11.56% (JPY), 1.82% (EUR), 0.77% (CNY) and 0.05% (GBP), whereas the RUB appreciated by 0.55%.

Currencies of African Countries: During the week ending June 28, 2024, exchange rates for African currencies changed against the USD at varying degrees. Of the 37 African currencies reviewed, 11 currencies appreciated against the USD on a week on a week basis, while 24 currencies depreciated. The exchange rates of the South Sudanese Pound (SSP) and the Somali Shilling (SOS) to the USD remained unchanged during the week. The highest weekly currency appreciation was recorded for Zambian Kwacha (ZMK), at 5.18%, while the biggest depreciation was recorded for the South African Rand (ZAR) at 1.49%. Compared to the corresponding period of last year, 7 out of 36 African currencies, excluding Zimbabwe's new currency (ZIG), recorded appreciations against the USD, with rates ranging between 7.97% for the Kenyan Shilling (KES) and 0.18% for Sudanese Pound (SDG). During the same period, 29 African currencies depreciated against the USD, 12 of which depreciated by more than 10.0%.
