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# Weekly Trends of Selected Commodity Prices and Exchange Rates of African and Major Global Currencies<sup>1</sup>:

*The situation as of Friday, September 13, 2024*

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## **Weekly Trends in Selected Commodity Prices and Exchange Rates of African and Major Global Currencies — Week Ended September 13, 2024**

### **Summary**

In the week of September 13, 2024, prices of crude oil, natural gas, metals, and agricultural commodities increased compared to the previous week. In contrast to the corresponding period of last year, prices were lower for some commodities including crude oil, natural gas, nickel, wheat HRW, corn CBT, rice, sugar, cotton and phosphoric rock. The Euro, the British Pound and the Japanese Yen, appreciated against the United States Dollar (USD) compared to the previous week, while the Chinese Yuan and the Russian Ruble depreciated against the USD. Compared to September 13, 2023 levels, the USD weakened against all the reviewed major currencies. Most of the reviewed African currencies depreciated against the USD when compared to the levels in the previous week as well as the corresponding period of last year.

### **Energy**

**As of September 13, 2024, international prices for crude oil and natural gas were lower compared to the corresponding period of last year, although prices increased vis-a-vis the previous week.** On a week-on-week basis, prices of Brent crude oil, WTI crude oil and natural gas increased by 0.77%, 1.45%, and 1.32%, respectively. In comparison to the same period of last year, prices of Brent crude oil, WTI crude oil and natural gas fell by 14.56%, 13.93%, and 32.15%, respectively. Consequently, prices reached USD 71.61 and USD 68.65 per barrel for Brent crude oil and WTI crude oil respectively, and USD 2.31 per million Btu<sup>1</sup> for natural gas, as of September 13, 2024.

### **Metals**

**International prices of all reviewed metals increased on September 13, 2024, compared to the levels in the previous week. However, the prices were higher than their levels a year ago for all selected metals, except nickel.** Compared to the previous week, prices increased for silver by 9.97%, platinum by 8.00%, copper by 3.47%, gold by 3.21%, and nickel by 0.32%. In comparison to their levels on September 13, 2023, prices increased for most of the selected metals, specifically gold by 35.00%, silver by 34.5%, copper by 10.59%, and platinum by 10.37%. On the other hand, the price of nickel fell by 20.55%.

### **Agricultural Commodities**

**Prices increased for most selected agricultural commodities when compared to their levels in the previous week, but fell for some commodities relative to the levels last year.** On September 13, 2024, international prices of most selected agricultural commodities increased compared to the levels in the preceding week, particularly coffee arabica by 9.16%, cocoa by 6.55%, wheat HRW by 3.90%, cotton by 2.86%, rubber TSR20 by 2.32%, corn CBT by 1.82%, rice by 1.27%, and sugar by 0.73%, while the price of palm oil fell by 0.61%. Compared to the same period of last year, price increases were recorded for cocoa (161.86%), coffee arabica (73.49%), rubber TSR20 (31.44%) and palm oil (17.64%). In contrast, prices fell for wheat HRW (19.71%), sugar (17.96%), corn CBT (15.79%), cotton (13.25%), and rice (3.88%).








## Fertilizers

**As of September 13, 2024, the price of phosphoric rock was lower by 56.12%, while prices of TSP and DAP were higher by 19.41% and 5.21%, respectively, compared to the levels in the corresponding period of 2023.** When compared to the previous week, prices of TSP and DAP fell by 0.49% and 0.27% respectively, while the price of phosphoric rock remained unchanged.

## Exchange Rates

**Major Currencies:** During the week of September 13, 2024, three of the five selected major global currencies - the Euro (EUR), the British Pound (GBP) and the Japanese Yen (JPY) - appreciated against the USD while the Chinese Yuan (CNY) and the Russian Ruble (RUB) depreciated, relative to the previous week. The week-on-week rates of appreciation against the USD were 1.15% for the JPY, 0.08% for the GBP and 0.07% for the EUR. The RUB and CNY depreciated against the USD by 0.73% and 0.03% respectively, during the week. In comparison to the corresponding period of 2023, all the reviewed currencies appreciated against the USD, specifically by 5.23% (RUB), 4.84% (GBP), 4.44% (JPY), 3.10% (EUR) and 2.38% (CNY).

**Currencies of African Countries:** During the week of September 13, 2024, most African currencies depreciated against the USD with varying rates, both on weekly and annual basis. Of the 37 African currencies reviewed, 13 currencies appreciated against the USD when compared to the levels in the previous week, while 23 currencies depreciated. The exchange rate of Zimbabwe Gold (ZIG) to the USD remained unchanged during the week. The highest weekly currency appreciation was recorded for the Seychelles Rupee (SCR), at 3.00%, while the biggest depreciation was recorded for the Nigerian Naira (NGN) at 1.91%. Compared to the corresponding period of last year, 14 out of 36 African currencies, excluding Zimbabwe's new currency (ZIG), recorded appreciations against the USD, with rates ranging between 12.11% for the Kenyan Shilling (KES) and 0.12% for the Djibouti Franc (DJF). During the same period, 22 African currencies depreciated against the USD, 11 of which depreciated by more than 10.0%.
