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# Weekly Trends of Selected Commodity Prices and Exchange Rates of African and Major Global Currencies<sup>1</sup>:

*The situation as of Friday, September 20, 2024*

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## Weekly Trends in Selected Commodity Prices and Exchange Rates of African and Major Global Currencies — Week Ended September 20, 2024

### Summary

In the week of September 20, 2024, prices of crude oil, natural gas, most metals, and agricultural commodities increased compared to the previous week. In contrast to the corresponding period of last year, prices were lower for some commodities including crude oil, natural gas, nickel, wheat HRW, corn CBT, rice, sugar, cotton and phosphoric rock. The Euro, the British Pound and the Chinese Yuan appreciated against the United States Dollar (USD) compared to the previous week, while the Japanese Yen and Russian Ruble depreciated against the USD. Compared to September 20, 2023 levels, the USD weakened against all the reviewed major currencies. Most of the reviewed African currencies appreciated against the USD when compared to the levels in the previous week, while most currencies depreciated compared to the corresponding period of last year.

### Energy

**As of September 20, 2024, international prices for crude oil and natural gas were lower compared to the corresponding period of last year, although prices increased vis-a-vis the previous week.** On a week-on-week basis, prices of Brent crude oil, WTI crude oil and natural gas increased by 4.02%, 4.80%, and 5.60%, respectively. In comparison to the same period of last year, prices of Brent crude oil, WTI crude oil and natural gas fell by 11.30%, 10.51%, and 27.58%, respectively. Consequently, prices reached USD 74.49 and USD 71.00 per barrel for Brent crude oil and WTI crude oil respectively, and USD 2.43 per million Btu<sup>1</sup> for natural gas, as of September 20, 2024.

### Metals

**International prices of most reviewed metals increased on September 20, 2024, compared to the levels in the previous week and prices were also mostly higher than their levels a year ago for most selected metals.** Compared to the previous week, prices increased for nickel by 3.55%, copper by 1.81%, gold by 1.71% and silver by 1.49%, whereas the price of platinum fell by 1.93%. In comparison to their levels on September 20, 2023, prices increased for most of the selected metals, specifically gold by 34.68%, silver by 32.17%, copper by 13.55%, and platinum by 4.17%. In contrast, the price of nickel fell by 15.74%.

### Agricultural Commodities

**Prices increased for most selected agricultural commodities when compared to their levels in the previous week but fell for some commodities relative to the levels of last year.** On September 20, 2024, international prices of most selected agricultural commodities increased compared to the levels in the preceding week, particularly sugar by 17.16%, rubber TSR20 by 5.51%, cotton by 5.30%, palm oil by 4.91%, corn CBT by 2.82% and rice by 0.39%. In contrast, prices fell for cocoa by 24.02%, wheat HRW by 6.00% and coffee arabica by 4.31%, during the week. Compared to the same period of last year, price increases were recorded for cocoa (114.51%), coffee arabica (58.50%), rubber TSR20 (38.58%) and palm oil (22.65%). In contrast, prices fell for wheat HRW (23.45%), corn CBT (16.69%), cotton (9.81%), sugar (5.29%), and rice (2.54%).

## Fertilizers

As of September 20, 2024, the price of phosphoric rock was lower by 56.12%, while prices of TSP and DAP were higher by 18.82% and 3.27%, respectively, compared to the levels in the corresponding period of 2023. When compared to the previous week, prices of TSP and DAP fell by 0.49% and 0.45% respectively, while the price of phosphoric rock remained unchanged.

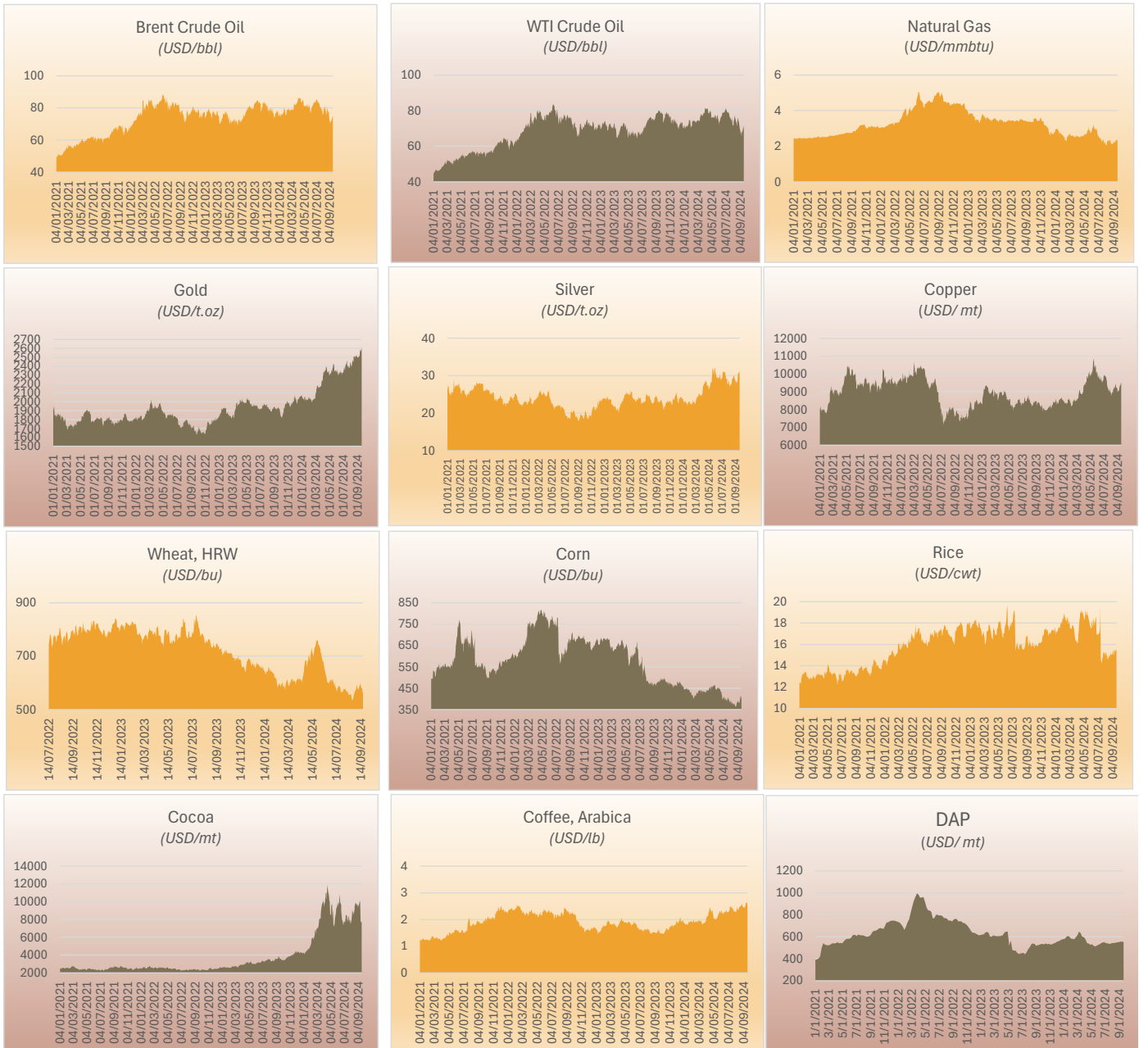
## Exchange Rates

**Major Currencies:** During the week of September 20, 2024, three of the five selected major global currencies - the Euro (EUR), the British Pound (GBP) and the Chinese Yuan (CNY)- appreciated against the USD, while the Japanese Yen (JPY) and the Russian Ruble (RUB) depreciated, relative to the previous week. The week-on-week rates of appreciation against the USD were 1.47% for the GBP, 0.81% for the EUR and 0.78% for the CNY. The JPY and RUB depreciated against the USD by 2.09% and 1.39% respectively, during the week. In comparison to the corresponding period of 2023, all the reviewed currencies appreciated against the USD, specifically by 6.82% (GBP), 4.38% (RUB), 3.93% (EUR), 3.37% (CNY) and 2.57% (JPY).

**Currencies of African Countries:** During the week of September 20, 2024, most African currencies depreciated against the USD with varying rates, both on weekly and annual basis. Of the 37 African currencies reviewed, 18 currencies appreciated against the USD when compared to the levels in the previous week, while 16 currencies depreciated. The exchange rates of the Congolese (DRC) Franc (CDF), the Kenyan Shilling (KES) and the Somali Shilling (SOS), to the USD, remained unchanged during the week. The highest weekly currency appreciation was recorded for the South African Rand (ZAR), at 1.49%, while the biggest depreciation was recorded for the Ethiopian Birr (ETB) at 3.23%. Compared to the corresponding period of last year, 14 out of 36 African currencies, excluding Zimbabwe's new currency (ZIG), recorded appreciations against the USD, with rates ranging between 12.45% for the Kenyan Shilling (KES) and 0.01% for the Mozambique New Metical (MZN). During the same period, 22 African currencies depreciated against the USD, 11 of which depreciated by more than 10.0%.
