## Weekly Trends in Selected Commodity Prices and Exchange Rates of African and Major Global Currencies — Week Ended October 18, 2024

### Summary

In the week of October 18, 2024, prices of crude oil, natural gas, few metals, and some agricultural commodities fell compared to the previous week. In comparison to the corresponding period of last year, as well, prices were lower for crude oil, natural gas, nickel, phosphoric rock and agricultural commodities including wheat HRW, corn CBT, rice, sugar and cotton. The Euro, the British Pound, the Japanese Yen, and the Chinese Yuan depreciated against the United States Dollar (USD) compared to the previous week, while the Russian Ruble appreciated. Compared to October 18, 2023 levels, the USD weakened against all of the reviewed major currencies. Most of the reviewed African currencies depreciated against the USD when compared to the levels in the previous week as well as the corresponding period of last year.

### Energy

**As of October 18, 2024, international prices for crude oil and natural gas were lower compared to the corresponding period of last year, as well as the previous week.** On a week-on-week basis, prices of Brent crude oil, WTI crude oil and natural gas fell by 7.57%, 8.39% and 14.21%, respectively. Likewise, in comparison to the same period of last year, prices of Brent crude oil, WTI crude oil and natural gas were lower by 12.37%, 12.60% and 41.01%, respectively. Consequently, prices reached USD 73.06 and USD 69.22 per barrel for Brent crude oil and WTI crude oil respectively, and USD 2.26 per million Btu<sup>1</sup> for natural gas, as of October 18, 2024.

### Metals

**International prices of some of the reviewed metals increased in the week ended October 18, 2024, compared to their levels in the previous week, and prices were also higher than their levels a year ago for most selected metals.** Compared to the previous week, prices increased for silver by 6.90%, platinum by 2.79% and gold by 2.44%, In contrast, prices fell for nickel by 5.41% and copper by 1.70%, during the week. In comparison to their levels in the week of October 18, 2023, prices increased for most of the selected metals, specifically silver by 47.37%, gold by 39.57%, copper by 20.73%, and platinum by 14.05%, whereas price of nickel fell by 9.42%.

### Agricultural Commodities

**Prices fell for some selected agricultural commodities when compared to their levels in the previous week and corresponding period of last year.** On October 18, 2024, international prices of selected agricultural commodities fell compared to the levels in the preceding week, particularly wheat HRW by 3.93%, cocoa by 3.73%, corn CBT by 2.65%, cotton by 1.69% and sugar by 0.27%. In contrast, prices increased for coffee arabica by 2.08%, palm oil by 0.42%, rubber TSR20 by 0.35% and rice by 0.03%, during the week. Compared to the same period of last year, prices increased for cocoa (104.73%), coffee arabica (62.80%), rubber TSR20 (33.47%) and palm oil (26.29%). In contrast, prices fell for wheat HRW (18.20%), corn CBT (17.73%), cotton (12.94%), sugar (9.14%), and rice (5.42%).

## Fertilizers

As of October 18, 2024, the price of phosphoric rock was lower by 56.12%, while prices of TSP and DAP were higher by 14.37 and 9.39%, respectively, compared to the levels in the corresponding period of 2023. When compared to the previous week, prices remained unchanged for TSP and phosphoric rock, while price of DAP increased by 1.97%.

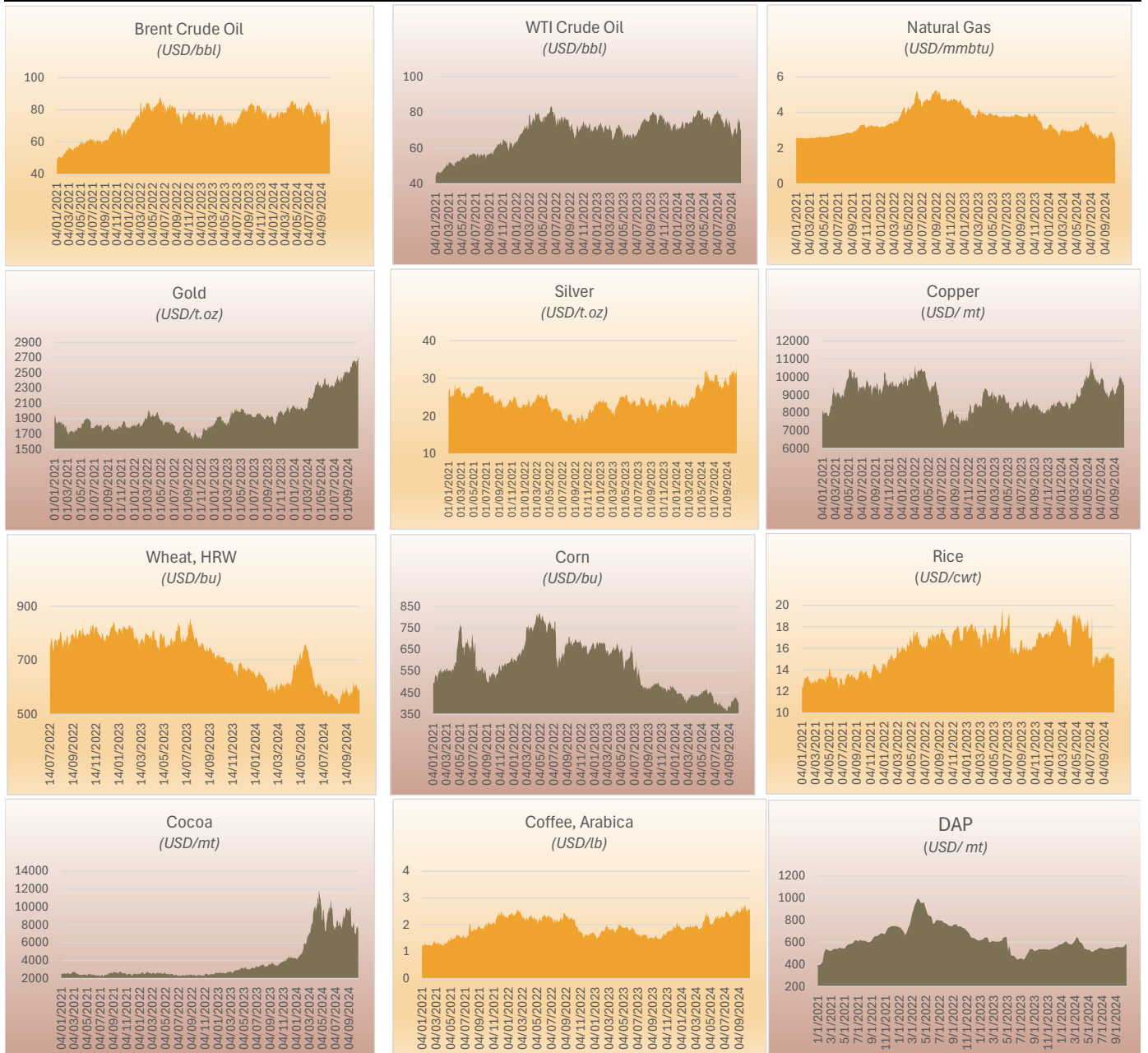
## Exchange Rates

**Major Currencies:** During the week of October 18, 2024, four of the five selected major global currencies - the Euro, the British Pound (GBP), the Japanese Yen (JPY) and the Chinese Yuan (CNY)– depreciated against the USD, while the Russian Ruble (RUB) appreciated, relative to the previous week. The week-on-week rates of depreciation against the USD were 0.71% for the EUR, 0.67% for the CNY, 0.28% for the JPY and 0.22% for the GBP. The RUB appreciated against the USD by 0.58%, during the review week. In comparison to the corresponding period of 2023, all of the reviewed currencies appreciated against the USD, specifically by 6.83% (GBP), 3.03% (EUR), 2.88% (CNY), 2.35% (RUB) and 0.27% (JPY).

**Currencies of African Countries:** During the week of October 18, 2024, most African currencies depreciated against the USD with varying rates, both on weekly and annual basis. Of the 37 African currencies reviewed, 11 currencies appreciated against the USD when compared to the levels in the previous week, while 26 currencies depreciated. The highest weekly currency appreciation was recorded for the South Sudanese Pound (SSP), at 7.53%, while the biggest depreciation was recorded for the Zimbabwe Gold (ZIG) at 2.01%. Compared to the corresponding period of last year, 14 out of 36 African currencies, excluding Zimbabwe's new currency (ZIG), recorded appreciations against the USD, with rates ranging between 13.73% for the Kenyan Shilling (KES) and 0.02% for the Djibouti Franc (DJF). During the same period, 22 African currencies depreciated against the USD, 10 of which depreciated by more than 10.0%.
