Weekly Statistical Bulletin: Selected Commodity Prices, Exchange Rates, and African Stock Markets

Summary

Prices of crude oil, natural gas and fertilizers increased in the week ended 15 May 2026 compared to the previous week, while prices fell for metals and most agricultural commodities. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices increased for crude oil, metals, most agricultural commodities and fertilizers. In contrast, natural gas saw price decline.

In terms of exchange rate movements, four of the five major global currencies reviewed — the Euro (EUR), the British Pound (GBP), the Japanese Yen (JPY), and the Chinese Yuan (CNY)— depreciated against the United States Dollar (USD) compared to the previous week, while Russian Ruble (RUB) appreciated. Relative to the same period of last year, the EUR, the GBP, the CNY, and the RUB appreciated against the USD, while the JPY depreciated. Most African currencies depreciated against the USD compared with the previous week, while most appreciated relative to the corresponding period of the previous year. Regarding equity market performance, most of the reviewed African stock markets recorded declines week-on-week, but recorded gains compared with the same period last year. Most reviewed Global stock markets declined relative to the previous week, although, all recorded year-on-year gains.

Energy

During the week under review, international prices of crude oil and natural gas increased compared to the previous week. Compared to the corresponding period last year, crude oil prices rose while natural gas prices declined. Week-on-week, the prices of Brent crude oil, WTI crude oil and natural gas increased by 7.87%, 10.48%, and 7.36%, respectively. In comparison to the corresponding period of last year, the prices of Brent and WTI were higher by 70.75%, and 74.83%, respectively, while price of natural gas was lower by 26.90%. Thus, as of 15 May 2026, prices reached USD 109.26 and USD 105.42 per barrel for Brent and WTI, respectively; and USD 2.96 per million Btu for natural gas.

Metals

International prices of all reviewed metals declined during the week ended 15 May 2026 compared to the preceding week; however, they remained higher than levels recorded in the corresponding period in 2025. Compared to the previous week, prices fell for manganese ore by 6.95%, silver by 5.41%, gold by 3.71%, platinum by 3.71%, nickel by 2.09%, copper by 0.13%, and cobalt by 0.001%. In comparison to their levels on 15 May 2025, prices of all reviewed metals increased, as follows: silver (133.64%), platinum (99.32%), cobalt (67.94%), copper (41.54%), gold (40.88%), manganese ore (20.08%), and nickel (17.08%).

Agricultural Commodities

During the week under review, international prices of most selected agricultural commodities declined compared with the previous week but remained higher than levels observed during the corresponding period last year. Week-on-week, prices fell for cotton by 4.86%, palm oil by 3.08%, cocoa by 2.70%, coffee arabica by 1.76%, and corn CBT by 0.11%. In contrast, prices of some commodities increased including rice (6.35%), wheat HRW (1.81%), sugar (0.75%), and rubber TSR20 (0.18%). Compared to their levels in the corresponding period of last year, prices increased for most reviewed commodities as follows: rubber TSR20 (26.17%), palm oil (23.74%), wheat HRW (14.52%), cotton (13.39%), and corn CBT by (1.62%). In contrast, prices declined for some commodities including cocoa (60.98%), coffee arabica (26.07%), sugar (14.60%), and rice (2.63%).

Fertilizers

In the week ended 15 May 2026, price of DAP increased by 3.63% and price of TSP by 2.76% compared to the previous week. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices increased by 31.86% for TSP and 18.05% for DAP. The price of phosphoric rock remained unchanged at USD 152.50 per metric ton compared to its levels in both the previous week and the corresponding period of last year.

Exchange Rates

Major Global Currencies: During the week under review, four of the five reviewed major global currencies – the Euro (EUR), the British Pound (GBP), the Japanese Yen (JPY), and the Chinese Yuan (CNY)– depreciated against the USD relative to the previous week, while the Russian Ruble (RUB) appreciated. The week-on-week rates of depreciation against the USD were 2.14% for the GBP, 1.28% for the JPY, 1.21% for the EUR, and 0.27% for the CNY. In contrast, the RUB appreciated against the USD, by 1.78%, during the week. In comparison to the corresponding period of 2025, four of the five reviewed currencies appreciated against the USD as follows: the RUB by 8.85%, the CNY by 5.44%, the EUR by 3.87%, and the GBP by 0.32%. The JPY depreciated by 8.98%.

Currencies of African Countries: Most of the reviewed African currencies depreciated against the USD during the week under review, while a few appreciated relative to the previous week. Of the 37 African currencies reviewed, 26 depreciated against the USD, while 10 appreciated. The exchange rate of the Sudanese Pound (SDG) against the USD, remained unchanged during the week. The South African Rand (ZAR) experienced the largest week-on-week depreciation at 1.59%, while the Congolese (DRC) Franc (CDF) recorded the highest appreciation at 2.55%. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, 19 of the reviewed currencies recorded varying degrees of appreciation against the USD, ranging between 0.13% for the Algerian Dinar (DZD) and 29.60% for the Zambian Kwacha (ZMK). However, 18 African currencies depreciated against the USD, with 2 of them depreciating by more than 10.0%.

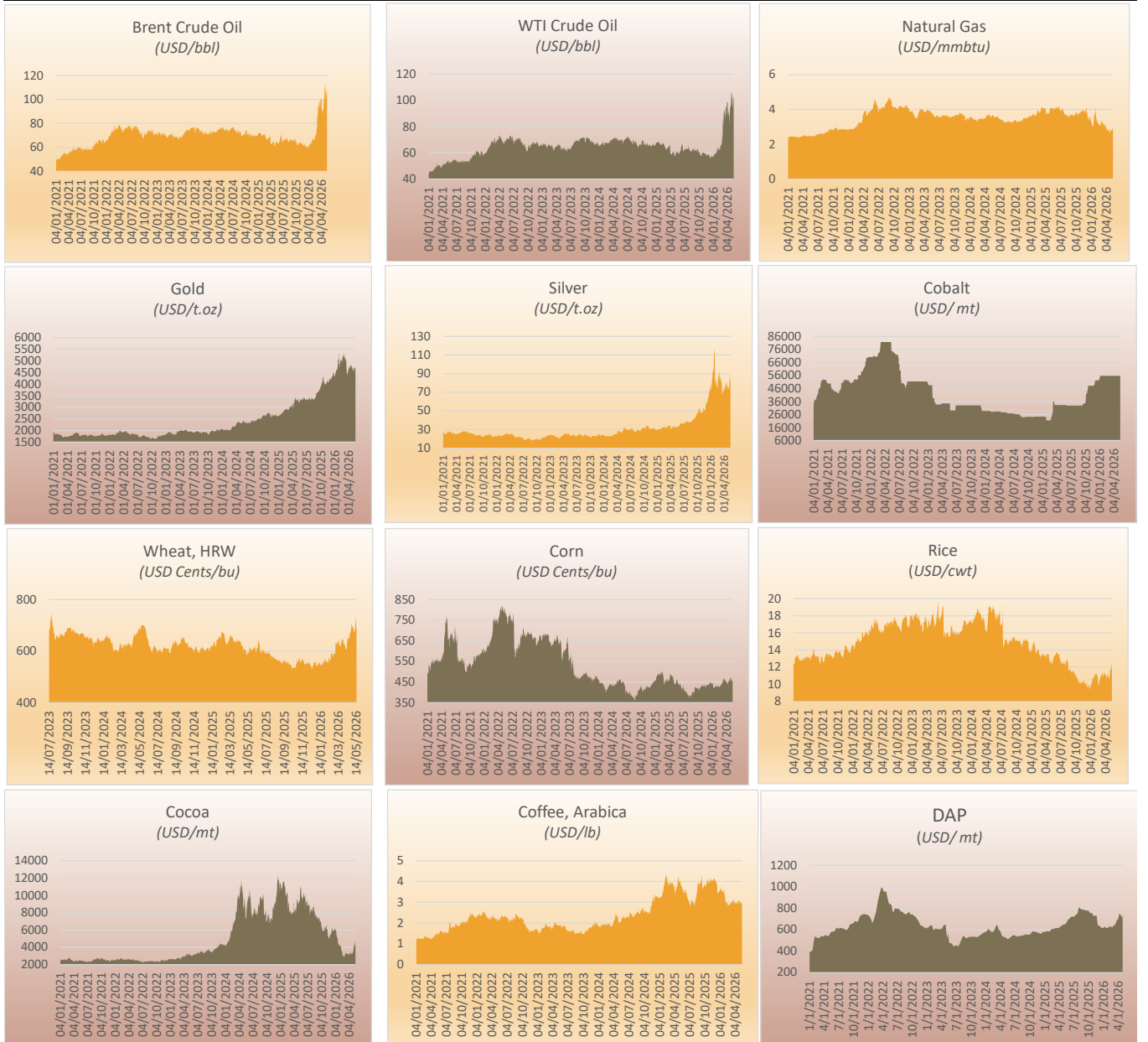
Stock Markets

During the week under review, most of the African stock markets reviewed declined compared with the previous week, while most posted gains relative to the corresponding period of last year. Of the 12 African stock market indices reviewed, 7 declined, while 5 recorded week-on-week gains. South Africa's JALSH Index experienced the largest decline at 2.84%, while Tunisia's TUNINDEX recorded the largest weekly increase at 5.18%. Compared to the corresponding period of last year, 11 of the 12 African stock markets reviewed recorded gains with Nigeria's NSE All Share Index leading at 129.17% followed by Ghana's GGSECI Index at 123.14%, while the Mauritius all Share Index declined by 4.83%.

Most of the global stock markets reviewed declined compared with the previous week, but all posted gains relative to the corresponding period last year. The largest weekly decline was experienced by Brazil's IBOVESPA (3.71%). Compared with the corresponding period of last year, all reviewed markets showed strong gains, with Japan's NIKKEI leading at 62.65%.
