Weekly Statistical Bulletin: Selected Commodity Prices, Exchange Rates, and African Stock Markets

Summary

Prices of crude oil, natural gas, most agricultural commodities, and TSP fertilizer declined in the week ended 22 May 2026 compared to the previous week, while prices increased for most metals. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices increased for crude oil, metals, most agricultural commodities and fertilizers. In contrast, the price of natural gas declined.

In terms of exchange rate movements, three of the five major global currencies reviewed —the British Pound (GBP), the Chinese Yuan (CNY), and the Russian Ruble (RUB)— appreciated against the United States Dollar (USD) compared to the previous week, while the Japanese Yen (JPY) and the Euro (EUR) depreciated. Relative to the same period of last year, the EUR, the GBP, the CNY, and the RUB appreciated against the USD, while the JPY depreciated. Most African currencies depreciated against the USD compared with the previous week, while most appreciated relative to the corresponding period of the previous year. Regarding equity market performance, most of the reviewed African stock markets recorded declines week-on-week, but recorded gains compared with the same period last year. Most global stock markets under review posted gains against both the prior week and the same period last year.

Energy

During the week under review, international prices of crude oil and natural gas declined compared to the previous week. Compared to the corresponding period last year, crude oil prices rose while natural gas prices declined. Week-on-week, the prices of Brent crude oil, WTI crude oil and natural gas declined by 5.24%, 4.38%, and 1.79%, respectively. In comparison to the corresponding period of last year, the prices of Brent and WTI were higher by 62.93% and 60.92%, respectively, while price of natural gas was lower by 27.99%. Thus, as of 22 May 2026, prices reached USD 103.54 and USD 96.60 per barrel for Brent and WTI, respectively; and USD 2.91 per million Btu for natural gas.

Metals

International prices of most reviewed metals increased during the week ended 22 May 2026 compared to the preceding week and remained higher than levels recorded in the corresponding period in 2025. Compared to the previous week, prices increased for nickel by 2.25%, copper by 0.83%, manganese ore by 0.32%, and cobalt by 0.02%. In contrast, prices of some commodities fell including platinum by 2.76%, gold by 0.68%, and silver by 0.59%. In comparison to their levels on 22 May 2025, prices of all reviewed metals increased, as follows: silver (128.39%), platinum (78.70%), cobalt (67.93%), copper (43.86%), gold (36.58%), nickel (22.07%), and manganese ore (15.73%).

Agricultural Commodities

During the week under review, international prices of most selected agricultural commodities declined compared with the previous week but remained higher than levels observed during the corresponding period last year. Week-on-week, prices fell for cocoa by 5.15%, coffee arabica by 4.30%, cotton by 3.96%, wheat HRW by 0.87%, and sugar by 0.68%. In contrast, prices of some commodities increased including rice (3.30%), corn CBT (1.65%), palm oil (0.84%), and rubber TSR20 (0.23%). Compared to their levels in the corresponding period of last year, prices increased for most reviewed commodities as follows: rubber TSR20 (29.40%), palm oil (24.79%), wheat HRW (11.12%), cotton (9.04%), rice (0.54%), and corn CBT by (0.05%). In contrast, prices declined for some commodities including cocoa (63.07%), coffee arabica (24.50%), and sugar (14.39%).

Fertilizers

In the week ended 22 May 2026, price of TSP declined by 1.34%, while price of DAP remained unchanged compared to the previous week. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices increased by 26.18% for TSP and 15.02% for DAP. The price of phosphoric rock remained unchanged at USD 152.50 per metric ton compared to its levels in both the previous week and the corresponding period of last year.

Exchange Rates

Major Global Currencies: During the week under review, three of the five reviewed major global currencies –the British Pound (GBP), the Chinese Yuan (CNY), and the Russian Ruble (RUB)– appreciated against the USD relative to the previous week, while the Euro (EUR) and the Japanese Yen (JPY) depreciated. The week-on-week rates of appreciation against the USD were 2.05% for the RUB, 0.84% for the GBP, and 0.28% for the CNY. In contrast, the JPY and the EUR depreciated against the USD, by 0.30% and 0.16% respectively, during the week. In comparison to the corresponding period of 2025, four of the five reviewed currencies appreciated against the USD as follows: the RUB by 10.54%, the CNY by 5.65%, the EUR by 2.95%, and the GBP by 0.20%. The JPY depreciated by 10.53%.

Currencies of African Countries: Most of the reviewed African currencies depreciated against the USD during the week under review, while a few appreciated relative to the previous week. Of the 37 African currencies reviewed, 25 depreciated against the USD, while 10 appreciated. The exchange rates of the Gambian Dalasi (GMD) and the Sudanese Pound (SDG), against the USD, remained unchanged during the week. Ghana’s Cedi (GHS) experienced the largest week-on-week depreciation at 1.61%, while the Seychelles Rupee (SCR) recorded the highest appreciation at 3.40%. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, 18 of the currencies recorded varying degrees of appreciation against the USD, ranging between 0.03% for the Malawi Kwacha (MWK) and 31.10% for the Zambian Kwacha (ZMK). However, 18 African currencies depreciated against the USD, with 2 of them depreciating by more than 15.0%.

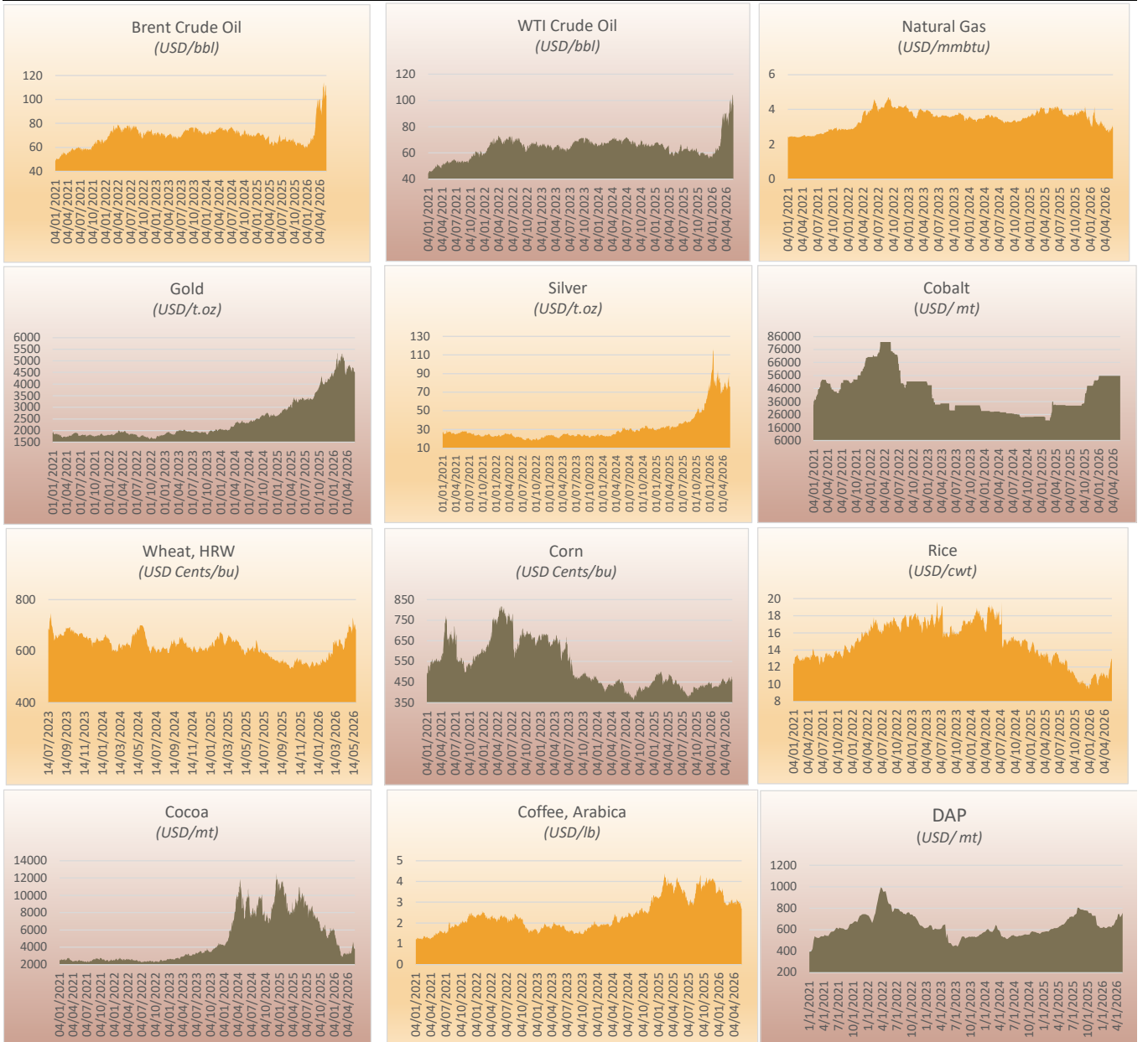
Stock Markets

During the week under review, most of the African stock markets reviewed declined compared with the previous week, while most posted gains relative to the corresponding period of last year. Of the 12 African stock market indices reviewed, 8 declined, while 4 recorded week-on-week gains. Egypt’s CASE 30 Index experienced the largest decline at 2.00%, while Côte d’Ivoire’s CASE 30 Index recorded the largest weekly increase at 2.03%. Compared to the corresponding period of last year, 11 of the 12 African stock markets reviewed recorded gains with Nigeria’s NSE All Share Index leading at 128.71% followed by Ghana’s GGSECI Index at 127.52%, while the Mauritius all Share Index declined by 7.07%.

Most of the global stock markets reviewed recorded gains compared with the previous week, as well as the corresponding period last year. The largest weekly increase was recorded for Germany’s DAX (3.92%). Compared with the corresponding period of last year, all reviewed markets showed strong gains, with Japan’s NIKKEI leading at 71.25%.
