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# Weekly Statistical Bulletin: Selected Commodity Prices, Exchange Rates, and African Stock Markets

## Summary

Prices of crude oil, most metals, and most agricultural commodities declined in the week ended 26 June 2026 compared to the previous week. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices increased for crude oil, metals, most agricultural commodities and fertilizers. In contrast, natural gas and a few agricultural commodities recorded price declines.

In terms of exchange rate movements, all the five major global currencies reviewed — the Euro (EUR), the British Pound (GBP), the Chinese Yuan (CNY), Japanese Yen (JPY), and the Russian Ruble (RUB)—depreciated against the United States Dollar (USD) compared to the previous week. Relative to the same period of last year, the EUR, the GBP, the JPY, and the RUB depreciated against the USD, while the CNY appreciated. Most African currencies depreciated against the USD compared with the previous week and the corresponding period of the previous year. Regarding equity market performance, most of the reviewed African stock markets declined on a week-on-week basis but recorded gains compared to the corresponding period of last year. Similarly, most of the reviewed global stock markets posted declines relative to the previous week, but recorded strong gains when compared to the same period a year earlier.

## Energy

**During the week under review, international prices of crude oil declined compared to the previous week while natural gas recorded a price increase. Relative to the corresponding period last year, crude oil prices rose while natural gas price declined.** Week-on-week, prices of Brent crude oil and WTI crude oil declined by 10.65% and 8.73%, respectively, while the price of natural gas increased by 0.09%. In comparison with the corresponding period of last year, the prices of Brent and WTI were higher by 10.74% and 12.55%, respectively, while the price of natural gas was lower by 23.87%. Thus, as of 26 June 2026, prices reached USD 71.99 and USD 69.23 per barrel for Brent and WTI, respectively; and USD 3.28 per million Btu for natural gas.

## Metals

**International prices of most reviewed metals declined during the week ended 26 June 2026 compared to the preceding week, but prices remained higher than levels recorded in the corresponding period of 2025 for all reviewed metals.** Compared to the previous week, prices fell, particularly for silver by 8.86%, nickel by 5.01%, platinum by 2.54%, copper by 1.75%, gold by 1.61%, and manganese ore by 0.50%. In contrast, the price of cobalt increased by 0.01%. In comparison with their levels on 26 June 2025, prices of all reviewed metals increased, as follows: cobalt (69.81%), silver (61.27%), copper (34.93%), gold (22.73%), manganese ore (16.86%), platinum (15.26%), and nickel (9.80%).

## Agricultural Commodities

**During the week under review, international prices of most selected agricultural commodities declined compared with the previous week but rose compared to the corresponding period last year.** Week-on-week, prices declined for TSR20 by 7.82%, wheat HRW by 4.88%, cotton by 4.13%, corn CBT by 1.14%, and palm oil by 0.84%. In contrast, prices increased for cocoa by 21.02%, rice by 7.33%, coffee arabica by 4.23%, and sugar by 2.69%. Compared to their levels in the corresponding period of last year, prices increased for most reviewed commodities as follows: rubber TSR20 (28.05%), palm oil (16.90%), cotton (9.79%), wheat HRW (1.77%), corn CBT by (0.79%), and rice (0.46%). In contrast, prices declined for some commodities including cocoa (46.44%), sugar (14.14%), and coffee arabica (7.35%).

## Fertilizers

In the week ended 26 June 2026, prices of phosphoric rock and TSP increased by 11.48% and 0.35%, respectively, while price of DAP declined by 0.64% compared to the previous week. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices increased by 19.50% for TSP, 11.48% for phosphoric rock, and 7.24% for DAP.

## Exchange Rates

**Major Global Currencies:** During the week under review, all the five reviewed major global currencies – the Euro (EUR), the British Pound (GBP), the Chinese Yuan (CNY), the Japanese Yen (JPY), and the Russian Ruble (RUB)– depreciated against the USD relative to the previous week. The week-on-week rates of depreciation against the USD were 7.59% for the RUB, 0.70% for the EUR, 0.27% for the CNY, 0.26% for the JPY, and 0.17% for the CNY. In comparison to the corresponding period of 2025, four of the five reviewed currencies depreciated against the USD as follows: the JPY by 12.14%, the GBP by 4.15%, the EUR by 2.99%, and the RUB by 0.15%. The CNY appreciated by 5.00%.

**Currencies of African Countries:** Most of the reviewed African currencies depreciated against the USD during the week under review, while some appreciated relative to the previous week. Of the 37 African currencies reviewed, 22 depreciated against the USD, while 13 appreciated. The exchange rates of the Mauritania Ouguiya (MRU) and the Sudanese Pound (SDG) against the USD remained unchanged during the week. The Nigerian Naira (NGN) experienced the largest week-on-week depreciation at 1.09%, while the Seychelles Rupee (SCR) recorded the highest week-on-week appreciation at 2.85%. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, 15 of the reviewed currencies recorded varying degrees of appreciation against the USD, ranging between 0.01% for the Mozambique Metical (MZN) and 23.32% for the Zambian Kwacha (ZMW). However, 22 African currencies depreciated against the USD, with 2 of them depreciating by more than 15.0%.

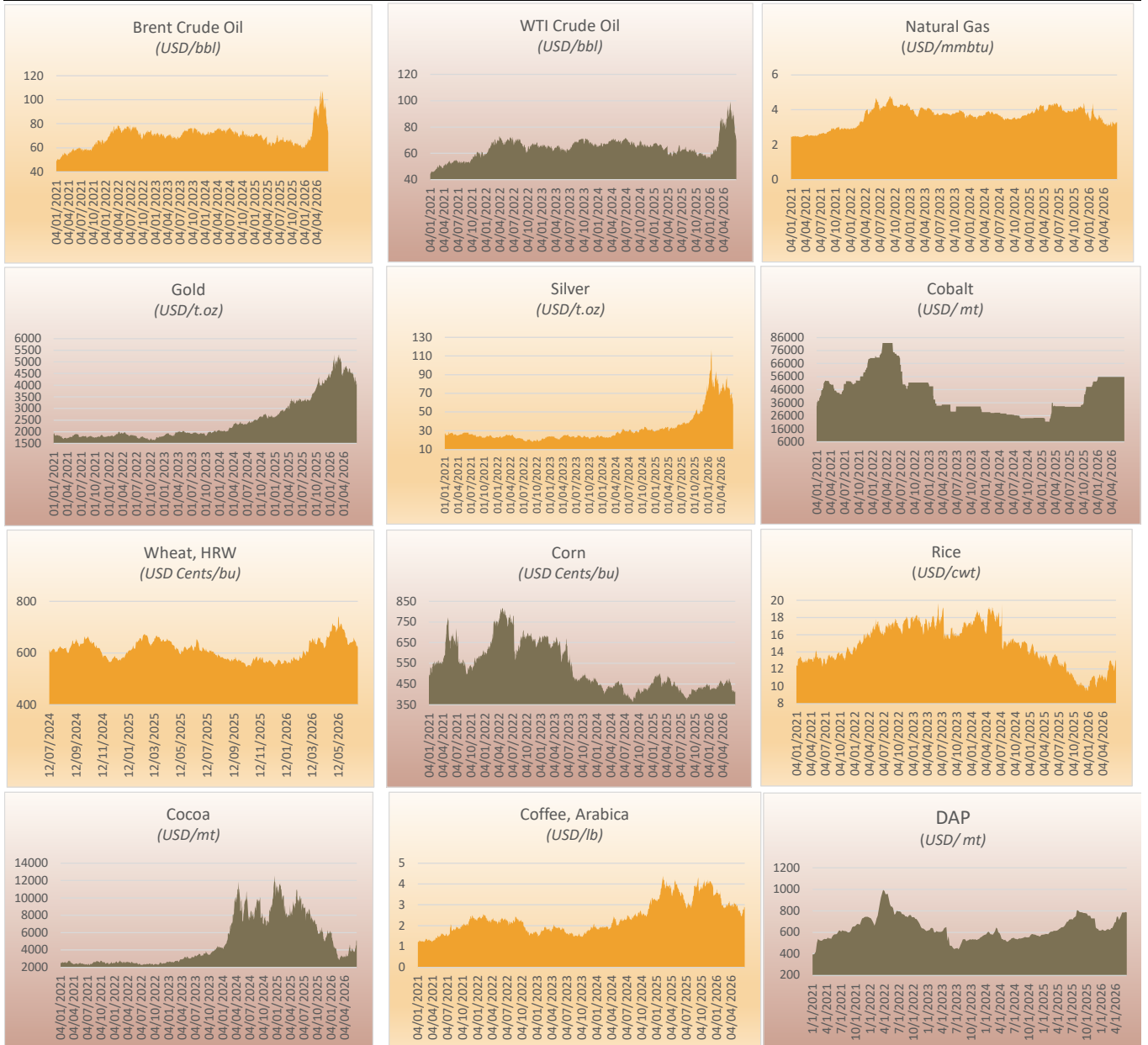
## Stock Markets

Most the African stock markets reviewed declined compared with the previous week, but recorded gains relative to the corresponding period of last year. Of the 12 African stock market indices reviewed, 7 declined, while 5 recorded week-on-week gains. Namibia's FTSE NSX Overall Index experienced the largest week-on-week decline at 4.12%, while Tunisia's TUNINDEX recorded the largest week-on-week increase at 6.34%. Compared to the corresponding period of last year, 10 of the 12 African stock markets reviewed recorded gains with Ghana's GGSECI Index leading at 136.54% followed by Nigeria's NSE All Share Index at 92.13%.

Most of the global stock markets reviewed declined when compared with their levels in the previous week, but recorded gains relative to the corresponding period of last year. The largest week-on-week decline was experienced by Japan's NIKKEI (2.65%). Compared with the corresponding period of last year, the reviewed markets showed strong gains, with Japan's NIKKEI leading at 80.21%.
