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# Weekly Statistical Bulletin: Selected Commodity Prices, Exchange Rates, and African Stock Markets

## Summary

Prices of crude oil, most metals and fertilizers increased in the week ended 27 March 2026, compared to the previous week while prices of natural gas and most reviewed agricultural commodities declined. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices fell for natural gas and most reviewed agricultural commodities. In contrast, crude oil, all reviewed metals, and fertilizers recorded price increases.

In terms of exchange rate movements, four of the five major global currencies reviewed — the Euro (EUR), the British Pound (GBP), the Japanese Yen (JPY), and the Chinese Yuan (CNY)— depreciated against the United States Dollar (USD) compared to the previous week, while the Russian Ruble (RUB) appreciated. Relative to the same period of last year, the EUR, the GBP, the CNY, and the RUB appreciated against the USD, while the JPY depreciated. Most African currencies depreciated against the USD compared with the previous week but appreciated compared to the corresponding period of the previous year. Regarding equity market performance, most of the African stock markets declined compared with the previous week but recorded gains compared to the corresponding period of last year. Global stock markets broadly improved compared with the previous week as well as year on year.

## Energy

**During the week under review, international crude oil prices rose compared to both the previous week and the same period last year, while natural gas prices recorded decline.** Week-on-week, the prices of Brent crude oil and WTI crude oil increased by 0.34% and 1.44%, respectively, while the price of natural gas fell by 1.27%. In comparison to the corresponding period of last year, the prices of Brent and WTI were higher by 62.51%, and 52.05%, respectively, while price of natural gas was lower by 23.78%. Thus, as of 27 March 2026, prices reached USD 112.57 and USD 99.64 per barrel for Brent and WTI, respectively; and USD 3.03 per million Btu for natural gas.

## Metals

**International prices of most reviewed metals increased in the week ended 27 March 2026, compared to their levels in the preceding week. They also remained higher relative to the corresponding period in 2025 for all reviewed metals.** Compared to the previous week, prices increased for silver by 2.67%, copper by 2.23%, nickel by 0.98%, gold by 0.04%, and cobalt by 0.03%, whereas the price of platinum declined by 4.92%, and manganese ore remained unchanged. In comparison to their levels on 27 March 2025, prices of all reviewed metals increased, as follows: silver (103.32%), platinum (89.70%), cobalt (66.75%), gold (47.20%), copper (23.85%), nickel (5.78%), and manganese ore by 2.74%.

## Agricultural Commodities

**During the week under review, international prices of most selected agricultural commodities declined compared with the previous week as well as the corresponding period last year.** Week-on-week, prices declined for cocoa by 2.76%, palm oil by 2.73%, coffee arabica by 2.60%, corn CBT by 0.75%, and rice by 0.05%. In contrast, prices of some commodities increased, including rubber TSR20 (5.81%), wheat HRW (4.37%), cotton (3.19%), and sugar (0.38%). Compared to their levels in the corresponding period of last year, prices declined for most reviewed commodities as follows: cocoa (60.33%), coffee arabica (20.35%), rice (17.64%), sugar (14.44%), cotton (3.69%), and wheat HRW (2.32%). In contrast, prices increased for a few commodities including palm oil by 6.88%, corn CBT by 2.67%, and rubber TSR20 by 0.15%.

## Fertilizers

In the week ended 27 March 2026, the prices of TSP and DAP increased by 6.02% and 4.37%, respectively compared to the previous week. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, prices increased by 31.78% for TSP and 12.15% for DAP. The price of phosphoric rock remained unchanged at USD 152.50 per metric ton compared to its levels in both the previous week and the corresponding period of last year.

## Exchange Rates

**Major Global Currencies:** During the week under review, four of the five reviewed major global currencies – the Euro (EUR), the British Pound (GBP), the Japanese Yen (JPY), and the Chinese Yuan (CNY) – depreciated against the USD relative to the previous week, while the Russian Ruble (RUB) appreciated. The week-on-week rates of depreciation against the USD were 0.70% for the JPY, 0.52% for the GBP, 0.39% for the EUR, and 0.21% for the CNY. The RUB appreciated against the USD by 2.14% during the week. In comparison to the corresponding period of 2025, four of the five reviewed currencies appreciated against the USD as follows: the EUR by 6.28%, the CNY by 4.81%, the RUB by 3.50%, and the GBP by 2.40%. The JPY depreciated by 6.13%.

**Currencies of African Countries:** Most of the reviewed African currencies depreciated against the USD during the week under review, while the rest appreciated relative to the previous week. Of the 37 African currencies reviewed, 23 depreciated against the USD, while 13 appreciated. The exchange rate of the Somali Shilling (SOS) to the USD remained unchanged during the week. The Nigerian Naira (NGN) experienced the largest week-on-week depreciation at 1.97%, while the Zambian Kwacha (ZMK) recorded the highest appreciation at 3.39%. When compared to the corresponding period of last year, 20 of the currencies recorded varying degrees of appreciation against the USD, ranging between 0.07% for Malawi's Kwacha (MWK) and 34.08% for the Zambian Kwacha (ZMK). However, 17 African currencies depreciated against the USD, with 2 of them depreciating by more than 20.0%.

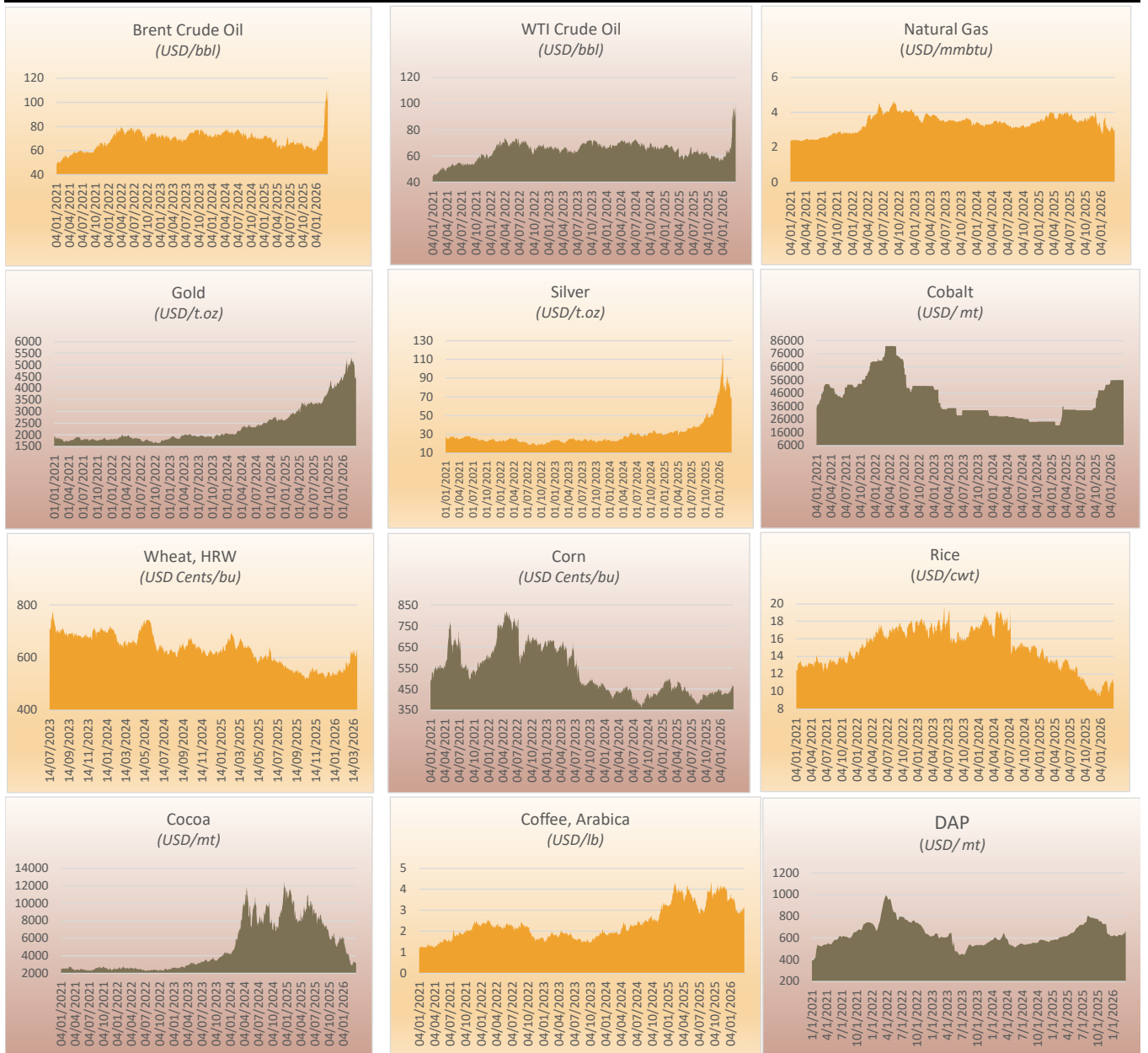
## Stock Markets

During the week under review, most of the African stock markets declined compared with the previous week but recorded gains compared to the corresponding period of last year. Of the 12 African stock market indices reviewed, 8 experienced week-on-week declines, while 3 recorded gains. Namibia's FTSE NSX Overall Index recorded the largest weekly increase at 2.76%, while Ghana's GGSECI Index registered the steepest decline at 17.23%. Compared to the corresponding period of last year, 10 of the 12 African stock markets reviewed recorded gains, while the Mauritius all Share Index declined by 10.45% and Morocco's Casa all shares Index declined by 2.10%.

During the week under review, global stock markets broadly recorded gains compared with the previous week as well as the corresponding period of last year. The largest weekly increase was recorded for Brazil's IBOVESPA (3.03%). Compared with the corresponding period of last year, the selected markets showed strong gains, with Japan's NIKKEI leading at 41.20%.
